AVAILABLE DPHSS SERVICES:

- 1. Immunizations are for children 2 months to 18 years old who are enrolled with Medicaid, MIP or has No Insurance**
 - DTaP, IPV, Hep B, Hep A, Hib, Prevnar, MMR, Tdap, Td, MCV, HPV, Annual Flu (While supplies last)
 - TB (PPD) skin tests will not be offered, it's not a vaccine
- 2. FREE Adult and Children's Physical Exam**
- 3. Health Education on Diabetes, Tobacco, and Hypertension**
- 4. Program Eligibility Assessment on the following:**
 - Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program
 - Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program
- 5. Information and General Assistance on the following:**
 - Vital Statistics (Marriage, Birth, and Death Certificates)
 - Mental health and essential services offered at the Guam Community Health Centers
 - Aging Programs - Title III Home and Community Based Services
 - Doula Services by the Bureau of Women's Affairs

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR CHILDREN BELOW 18 YEARS OF AGE TO AVAIL OF THE IMMUNIZATION SERVICES:

- Child's current shot record (Yellow Shot Card)
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Children below 18 years of age: Must be accompanied by a parent. If other than parent, adult must have legal documents or written authorization from parent.
- Parent, guardian or authorized adult's photo ID.
