AVAILABLE DPHSS SERVICES:

1. Immunizations are for children 2 months to 18 years old who are enrolled with Medicaid, MIP or has No Insurance
 - TB (PPD) skin tests will not be offered, it's not a vaccine
2. **FREE Adult and Children's Physical Exam**
3. **Health Education on Diabetes, Tobacco, and Hypertension**
4. **Program Eligibility Assessment on the following:**
 - Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program
 - Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program
5. **Information and General Assistance on the following:**
 - Child Care Assistance Program, Foster Parent Information, Questions & Answers about Child Protective Services
 - Mental health and essential services offered at the Guam Community Health Centers
 - Aging Programs - Medicare Assistance, Title III Home and Community Based Services, as well as Protection and Advocacy Adult Protective Services (APS)
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, SNAP Employment and Training Program, and TANF/Job Opportunities and Basic Skills Program
 - Doula Services

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR CHILDREN BELOW 18 YEARS OF AGE TO AVAIL OF THE IMMUNIZATION SERVICES:

- Child's current shot record (Yellow Shot Card)
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Children below 18 years of age: Must be accompanied by a parent. If other than parent, adult must have legal documents or written authorization from parent.
- Parent, guardian or authorized adult's photo ID.
