Judiciary of Guam Welcomes Rebecca M.P. Copper, Esq. as Small Claims Referee

Hagåtña, Guam — The Judiciary of Guam welcomed Rebecca M.P. Copper, Esq., to the bench during an investiture ceremony held at 10:00 a.m. in the Justice Monessa G. Lujan Appellate Courtroom. As the Judiciary's Small Claims Referee, Copper will play an important role in expanding the court's capacity by providing docket relief to judicial officers in the Small Claims Division and strengthening support for the Traffic Court Division.

During the ceremony, Copper expressed her appreciation for the opportunity to serve the people of Guam, *"I'm grateful for this opportunity, and I really hope that I can be of some service for docket relief and service to the community,"* said Copper.

Chief Justice Katherine A. Maraman reflected on Copper's legal experience and commitment to public service, *"I remember being on the bench when she appeared in my court from the Attorney General's Office. At the time she was helping with the children in need and child protective services,"* said Chief Justice Maraman. *"Her experience serving vulnerable members of our community and her dedication to public service will be an asset to the Judiciary."*

Rebecca M.P. Copper, Esq., brings nearly three decades of legal and public service experience to the Judiciary of Guam. She earned her Juris Doctor from the University of Arizona and has served in leadership roles with the Guam Department of Revenue and Taxation, the Office of the Attorney General of Guam, the Guam Department of Education, Guam Legal Services Corporation, and private practice. Throughout her career, she has represented government agencies, overseen legal divisions, managed federal programs, and advocated for Guam's families and children.

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
