DPHSS Brings Free Health and Social Services to Piti

Hagåtña, Guam – The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) lead by the Community Health Center is inviting the residents to join the **Piti Village Outreach Event on Friday, February 20, 2026 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** at the **Piti Social Hall**.

This village outreach is part of DPHSS's effort to bring essential health and social service resources directly into the heart of Guam's communities. Families are encouraged to come, learn, and take advantage of **free education, information, and on-site services** designed to promote healthier living.

Our DPHSS Services Available:

- **Immunizations** are for children 2 months to 18 years old who are enrolled with Medicaid, MIP or has No Insurance.
 - TB (PPD) skin tests will not be offered, it's not a vaccine
- **FREE** Adult and Children's Physical Exams
- **Education** on Diabetes, Tobacco, and Hypertension
- **Program Eligibility Assessment on the following:**
 - Breast and Cervical Cancer Screening Program
 - Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program
- **Information and General Assistance on the following:**
 - Child Care Assistance Program, Foster Parent Information, Questions and Answers about Child Protective Service
 - Mental Health and Primary Care Services offered at the Community Health Centers
 - Aging Programs – Medicare Assistance, Title III Home and Community Based Services, as well as Protection and Advocacy Adult Protective Services (APS)
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), SNAP Employment and Training Program, and TANF/Job Opportunities and Basic Skills Program
 - Doula Services

What to bring for Immunizations:

- Child's birth certificate
- Child's current shot record
- Children under 18 must be accompanied by a parent. If accompanied by another adult, legal documentation or written authorization from the parent is required.
- Parent, guardian, or authorized adult's valid photo ID

Why It Matters:

This event is DPHSS's 4th Village Outreach for FY2026, a community-centered effort to meet residents where they are and make health and wellness services more accessible. By working alongside village mayors and local partners, DPHSS aims to ensure that every resident has the chance to receive care, ask questions, and stay informed.
