CHANGES:

Bidder No.: 1 dated 04/07/2025:

QUESTION:

1. We need to know the approximate distance from the proposed charging station locations to the main connection point / panel. There are no measurements in the plans/maps.

ANSWER:

Site 1 is approximately 100 feet and Site 2 is approximately 650 feet. Please note, the footage provided are estimates and may change upon final design.

QUESTION:

2. Is GPA able to provide any as-builts of the areas for the proposed construction site? Our main concern is the conflict with the storm drain line right next to the charging station.

ANSWER:

Yes, as this is a design-build, as-builts of the facility will be provided and any design concerns can be addressed accordingly.

QUESTION:

3. Does GPA require a Guam stamp, or is a US state sufficient?

ANSWER:

Guam stamp.

Bidder No.: 1 dated 04/08/2025:

QUESTION:

1. We need to know the approximate distance from the proposed charging station locations to the main connection point / panel. There are no measurements in the plans/maps.

ANSWER:

Site 1 is approximately 100 feet and Site 2 is approximately 650 feet. Please note, the footage provided are estimates and may change upon final design.

QUESTION:

2. Is GPA able to provide any as-builts of the areas for the proposed construction site? Our main concern is the conflict with the storm drain line right next to the charging station.

ANSWER:

Yes, as this is a design-build, as-builts of the facility will be provided and any design concerns can be addressed accordingly.

QUESTION:

3. Does GPA accept Taiwan CNS standard and VPC (Voluntary Product Certification) certification?

ANSWER:

Refer to page SP-3, line item 9 on Material Standards and also GC-19, item 3. Standards.

QUESTION:

4. Does GPA require for the charging station to have a function to collect payment, or is GPA providing this service free of charge to users?

ANSWER:

At this time, it shall be free of charge, however charges for public use may be proposed in the future.

QUESTION:

5. Is the existing power structure at the site sufficient to build 10 charging stations, plus 10 more for standby?

ANSWER:

As shown in the design concept, new transformers will be installed to ensure sufficient power to the charging stations and will be designed accordingly.

QUESTION:

6. Do we need to apply for power at the jobsite for this project, or will GPA provide power at no cost?

ANSWER:

Yes, standard work order and work clearance shall be applied for. Please refer to GC-16, item 21. Electrical Energy.

QUESTION:

7. Is there any time requirement for after service or maintenance? What are the protection specifications or regulations for typhoon impact?

ANSWER:

- Refer to Technical Specifications Section 01700 Contract Closeout Paragraph 1.5 for after service/maintenance requirements.
- b) Refer to Technical Specifications Section 01010 Paragraph 5 for Design Policy and Criteria.

QUESTION:

8. Additionally, we need to ask for a bid date extension for at least another 30 days.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1 and 2 of *CHANGES* above.

Bidder No.: 3 dated 04/08/2025:

QUESTION:

 We would like to request an extension of the bid submission deadline for the above-mentioned project from April 15, 2025, to April 30, 2025. This additional time will allow us to complete the necessary preparation for the design and materials sourcing.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1 and 2 of CHANGES above.

All other Terms and Conditions in the bid package shall remain unchanged and in full force.
