## QUESTIONS AND CONCERNS REPSONSES MCOG-25-002 COLLECTION & TRANSPORT/TOWING FOR ABANDONED VEHICLES AND DISPOSAL

## Question and Concern received by Buena Vista Environmental LLC on June 12, 2025.

1. **Question**: For the 15% performance bond – where will it base at? At 380 cars or a certain amount such as \$500K?

**Response:** This Invitation for bid requires a 15% bid guarantee. Pursuant to 5 GCA § 5212, all competitive sealed bidding for the procurement of supplies or services exceeding \$25,000.00 a 15% Bid Security of the total bid price must accompany the bid package. (*Example: A company's total bid amount offered of all listed items under this IFB is \$50,000.00, said company must submit a 15% bid guarantee in the amount of \$7,500.00 to accompany their bid proposal.*) Please refer to page 28 of 39 of this IFB, item #11.

## Question and Concern received by Big Ben & Co. on June 13, 2025.

- 1. **Question**: Vendor will be assessing and charging additional fees for each abandoned vehicle towed should the following occur:
  - Excessive trash/debris/items within the abandoned vehicle for towing/disposal.
  - The abandoned vehicle is located on private, non-government property

- Requiring additional staff to assist in any non-accessible abandoned vehicle (example-within heavy vegetation/jungle area).

**Response**: Conditions and possible locations of abandoned vehicles must be factored into bidders proposed costs.

2. **Question:** Any additional unforeseen requirement of staff or equipment to be used will be assessed and charged additional fees.

**Response:** Administrative fees and additional equipment fees must be factored into bidders proposed costs.





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 Question: Any towing/disposals from Central or Southern locations would be assessed an additional cost of \$200.00 per trip/load if disposal location is listed as Global Recycling.

**Response**: Location for disposal of abandoned vehicles is not identified at this time pending award of Invitation for Bid.

## Question and Concern received by Carona's Pacific Corporation on June 13, 2025.

1. Question: Does every bid require a bid bond no matter the amount or is there a minimum threshold of which a bid bond is required? As a small businessman I am almost precluded from submitting any bid as I have no capability of competing against other well-established business or well financed business. I have only started recently and while I do have the capability to provide the services in the bid request, I do not have the resource to place a bid bond of 15% per each bid. Can small businesses like mine be allowed a minimum deposit bond?

**Response:** Pursuant to 5 GCA § 5212, all competitive sealed bidding for the procurement of supplies or services exceeding \$25,000.00 requires a 15% bid guarantee. Please refer to page 28 of 39 of this IFB, item #11.

2. Question: If I am able to prayerfully find funds to be on various villages work and I succeed in some and lose in others, why is it necessary to keep my bid bond in your possession for a year for procurement that lose? Again, as a small business I cannot afford this requirement.

**Response**: A bid guarantee is required in the amount of 15% of a company's total bid offered. If a company is unsuccessful for an award, their bid guarantee will be returned immediately upon notification of bid status.
