QUESTION:

1. Upon review of Amendment No. II, the response for item no. I is not clear whether GPA will be responsible for the power outage fee or if the contractor shoulders it. Please clarify.

ANSWER:

GPA will assume charges for outages conducted during normal hours (7:30 A.M. - 4:30 P.M.). Any work conducted on Government of Guam observed holidays, after hours (4:30 P.M. – 7:30 A.M.), and weekends will be charged to contractor.

QUESTION:

2. Again, we respectfully request a waiver of the third-party Hi-pot testing (or dielectric testing) and certification for the bucket truck due to the absence of a locally accredited agency capable of conducting such testing.

ANSWER:

GPA will not waive the testing of the bucket truck. It is an ANSI and OSHA requirement even if the lines are de-energized to protect the contractor from electrical hazards. Through market research, GPA Engineering personnel was able to identify the company Moy Certs, Inc. available on island that can perform hi-pot certification for bucket trucks. Therefore, the Authority stands firm.

All other Terms and Conditions in the bid package shall remain unchanged and in full force.
