Bidder No.: 2 dated 12/17/2025:

QUESTION:

1. Section A.1 States requested devices will be “Multifunctional printer, scanner, copier, fax” and A.21 states “All devices shall have “walk-up” fax capability, and required”. The capabilities stated in B.1 Group 1 and B.5 Group 5 only state PRINT, SCAN, COPY. ***Can you please confirm that only B.1 Group 1 and B.5 Group 5 do NOT require fax capability?***

ANSWER:

Yes. Group 1 and Group 5 do not require fax feature.

QUESTION:

2. Section A.11 states that “Charges for prints (exceeding the allowance of black and white and color prints) shall be pooled and calculated monthly.”
Can you please confirm that the “pool” amounts are per Group and the pool amounts for each group are as indicated in Groups B.1 through B.7?

ANSWER:

Groups B.1 through B.7 indicate Group totals, and individual device print counts.

QUESTION:

3. Section A.16 states that “Group 1-4 shall be minimum 72 PPM (pages per minute) Black & White.”
Bidder No.: 2 respectfully requests that the minimum print speed for Group 4 be reduced to 70ppm Black & White as this change would allow more vendors and models to be considered, thereby promoting greater competition.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1. a. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

4. Section A.22 states that “Each device shall have a single pass automatic duplexing feeder, and have the capability to detect staples when scanning.”

Requiring the Automatic Document Feeder (ADF) to detect staples is not an industry standard and appears to be unique to a single manufacturer, making the specification restrictive. The industry standard is for the ADF to stop the scanning process if an obstruction—such as a paper clip or staple—interferes with the job.

Bidder No.: 2 respectfully requests that ability for the Automatic Document Feeder to detect staples be amended to make this capability optional as this change would allow more vendors and models to be considered, thereby promoting greater competition.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1. b. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

5. Section A.22 states that Automatic Document Feeder (ADF) Capacity and Speed:
Group 4-6: 20 sheets, minimum, 20 PPM (pages per minute).
Group 7: 20 sheets, minimum, 20 PPM (pages per minute), minimum.
Group 5-6: 50 sheets, minimum, 40 PPM (pages per minute), minimum.
Group 1-4: 75 sheets, minimum, 60 PPM (pages per minute), minimum.

There appears to be overlapping requirements for the ADF Capacity and Speed.

- 1) **Scanning speed is typically measured in “Images per Minute” or IPM. Do you mean IPM instead of PPM?**
- 2) **For ADF Capacity**
 - a. **Can you please clarify if Group 4 is to have an ADF capacity of 20 or 75 sheets?**
 - b. **Can you please clarify if Group 5 is to have an ADF capacity of 20 or 50 sheets?**
 - c. **Can you please clarify if Group 6 is to have an ADF capacity of 20 or 50 sheets?**
- 3) **For ADF Speed**
 - a. **Can you please clarify if Group 4 is to have an ADF speed of 20 or 60 Images per Minute?**
 - b. **Can you please clarify if Group 5 is to have an ADF speed of 20 or 40 Images per Minute?**
 - c. **Can you please clarify if Group 6 is to have an ADF speed of 20 or 40 Images per Minute?**

ANSWER:

- 1) Refer to No. 1. b. of **CHANGES** above.
- 2)
 - a. Group 4 shall have an ADF capacity of 20 sheets, minimum capacity.
 - b. Group 5 shall have an ADF capacity of 50 sheets, minimum capacity.
 - c. Group 6 shall have an ADF capacity of 50 sheets, minimum capacity.
- 3)
 - a. Group 4 shall have the capacity to output 20 images per minute, minimum.
 - b. Group 5 shall have the capacity to 40 images per minute, minimum.
 - c. Group 6 shall have the capacity to output 40 images per minute, minimum.

QUESTION:

6. Sections B.1.6.1, B.2.7.1, B.3.7.1, B.4.7.1, B.5.6.1, B.6.5.1, and B.7.1 state a requirement of “Unauthorized Copy/Print Control”
Can you please clarify this requirement? Is this requirement meant to control copies and prints with an Accounting feature that limits/controls copies/prints for authorized users?

ANSWER:

The requirement of “Unauthorized Copy/Print Control” is intended to only allow authorized users to use the features such as copy and print on the machine. This will allow control the misuse of resources on the machine by non-authorized users.

QUESTION:

7. Sections B.5.7.1, B.6.6.1, and B.7.8.1 state a requirement of “208/240 VAC 60 Hz 30 A or 110/120 VAC 60Hz 20A”
The devices requested in Groups 5, 6, and 7 are low/mid-level print devices that typically require a 15-amp outlet. Bidder No.: 2 respectfully request that the electrical requirement be amended to read “208/240 VAC 60 Hz 30 A or 110/120 VAC 60Hz 20A or 15A”.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1. c., 2. and 3. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

8. The deadline for submitting questions related to the IFB is currently set for **December 17, 2025 at 5:00 PM.**
To ensure a thorough and informed response, Bidder No.: 2 respectfully requests an extension to the questions deadline. This additional time would allow for follow-up inquiries that may arise from GPA’s responses to the questions included in this letter.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 7. b. of **CHANGES** above.

Bidder No.: 7 dated 12/28/2025:

QUESTION:

1. On page 3 of 33 for Amendment No. IV, Section 2 b., the groups appear to overlap when defining the copier “speed”. In specific, you wrote “Groups 4-6 should be minimum 30 ppm (pages per minute) Color” (**which makes some sense given the revised specifications**). Later, you wrote “Group 1-4 should be a minimum 72 ppm (pages per minute) Black & White”. Setting aside how silly it is to specify 72ppm rather than 70 ppm (not to mention serious favoritism given that all other copier makers have 70 ppm models, except the spurious dealer, Xerox Corporation, who unsurprisingly has an “up to 72ppm” print speed. Whatever that means in real terms), I respectfully request you revise this amendment to say “Group 1-3 should be a minimum 72ppm (pages per minute) Black & White”.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1. a. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

2. On page 5 of 33 for Amendment No. IV, Section 2 h., the groups appear to overlap when defining the characteristics of the Automatic Document Feeder. In specific, you wrote “20 sheets, minimum, 20 PPM (pages per minute) (**which makes some sense given the revised specifications**). Later, you wrote “Groups 1-4: 75 sheets, minimum, 60 PPM (pages per minute), minimum. I respectfully request you revise this amendment to say “Groups 1-: 75 sheets, minimum, 60 PPM (pages per minute), minimum. For the sake of clarity, although I think I know what you mean, these specifications are not clear. Perhaps, for Group 4-6, after the 20 PPM (pages per minute) text, you might add “,minimum.” for consistency.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1. b. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

3. To avoid the appear of favoritism in Amendment IV, we respectfully request that the rated speed of the Group 1-3 copiers be revised to a “minimum of 70 ppm”.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 1. a. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

4. Given that these changes significantly affect the copiers being requested, we respectfully request that you extend the bid until Friday January 2, 2026. If the holiday schedule makes that date impractical then Tuesday January 5, 2026 would be favorable.

ANSWER:

Refer to No. 6. and 7. a. of **CHANGES** above.

Bidder No.: 7 dated 12/30/2025:

QUESTION:

1. For Group 7, combining the General Specifications with the specific Group 7 specifications, no A4 monochrome Multi-function Copier/Printer is currently manufactured which provides all of the features you are requesting. When the actual print volumes are considered, 8 of the 13 machines in Group 7 are printing less than 1,000 pages per month. Another 4 are printing less than 3,000 pages per month. The Julale Satellite Office prints just over 6,000 pages per month. Please consider the specific specifications which severely limit the available copier/MFPs and our suggested remedies.

General Specifications (that limit available copiers or offer no copier):

- a) “Ability to detect staples while scanning” (not available on any 30 ppm A4 monochrome copier/MFP on Earth). Recommended solution: **remove this requirement for Group 7 machines.**
- b) “Three 500 sheet trays”. For this kind of low volume monochrome A4 copier/MFP, this requirement makes the available copiers much more expensive. Recommended solution: **require Two 500 sheet trays with a 100 sheet bypass tray, as a reasonable specification.**
- c) “All devices shall have automatic, electric staple finishers”. For this kind of low volume monochrome A4 copier/MFP, this requirement makes the available copiers much more expensive and only a few manufacturers make a copier or MFP of this type (Kyocera does and Xerox, sadly, doesn’t). Recommended solution: **remove this requirement for Group 7 machines and replace with an “electric 50-sheet” convenience stapler.**

ANSWER:

1. Group 7 will be re-evaluated. Devices (in that group) will be reassigned to bring (print volume) balance throughout the fleet.
 - a) Refer to No. 1. b. of **CHANGES** above.
 - b) Refer to No. 1. d. of **CHANGES** above.

c) Refer to No. 1. e. of **CHANGES** above.

QUESTION:

2. Group Specifications (that limit available copiers):

- a) **“Network Server Fax Enablement”** (not a feature offered for low volume monochrome A4 copier/MFPs). Recommended solution: **remove this requirement for Group 7 machines.**

If you leave the specifications, unchanged, all bidders will be forced to either offer an A4 **color** multi-function copier or upgrade to an **A3** (11”x17”) monochrome multifunction copier.

Although Amendment IV offers an improved set of specifications, these specifications are far from the best industry solution, for your needs, available to the commercial marketplace on Guam. Historically, on Guam, the preferred copier supplier has routinely convinced the government to lease copiers that are much larger than required for specific work center needs. Times are changing. By aggressively competing on every bid, Bidder No.: 7 has saved GovGuam, I’ve been told, more than \$2 Million in annual copier lease costs. For the first time in history, GovGuam agencies are reaching out to us for engineering analysis support. These services are free to GovGuam as a public service. Why not ask all of the bidders to study your organization and offer right-sized solutions for your needs?

ANSWER:

- a) The “Network Server Fax Enablement” shall be removed. Refer to No. 1. f. and 5. of **CHANGES** above.
- b) This public service will be considered for future bid solicitations.

All other Terms and Conditions in the bid package shall remain unchanged and in full force.






