		<ol> <li>The Chair reported that GBME will not be represented at the upcoming FSMB Tri-Regulatory (Medical-Nursing-Pharmacy) unless a GBME expresses interest to attend. In addition, the Chair informed the GBME that Asst AG Weinberg may represent the GBME at the next meeting to be held in San Diego.</li> <li>Impaired Provider Program: The Chair informed the GBME that he spoke with the Chair of the HI Medical Board, who expressed interest in pursuing this initiative with GBME. Dr. David stated a GBME working group met to explore options for providing access to a Professional Health Program (PHP) for Guam professionals; she subsequently contacted representatives from PHPs in HI, WA and OR. To date, WA is unable to provide assistance, but HI has expressed interest, so a teleconference is anticipated to be held next week. She invited others to join in on the call. In addition, she stated that FHP currently has an occupational safety program which includes drug testing program, so there might be an opportunity to work with FHP on building local capacity in the long term.</li> <li>P. Flores reported that the GBME letter was sent to the Speaker regarding the GBME position pertaining to the proposed legislation discussed at the last meeting. He also stated that the Speaker has noted that GBME had made significant progress in addressing and closing longstanding complaints. He urges the GBME to continue its efforts to close-out complaints as expeditiously as possible.</li> <li>The Chair stated that he plans on discussing the application review process with the HPLO Administrator based on her observations of the FSMB process and what other jurisdictions are doing. In addition, Asst AG Weinberg agreed to review Dr. Berg's suggestion to list applicants by a number rather than their name. In the meantime, the GBME could refer to an applicant numbering system until he completes his review.
