Reyes stated that some pharmacists may be unaware of P.L. 36-3, which permits e-scripts for controlled substances; therefore, he recommended the GBEP consider disseminating information to local pharmacies, as well as coordinating information between GBEP, GBME, and DPHSS/DEH since there are numerous off-island physicians currently obtaining licensure in Guam through the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact Council during the Guam Board of Medical Examiners meetings. A. Mariano stated that some pharmacies may be incapable of receiving/processing e-scripts until its software is updated.
