VI.	Chairperson's Report	 Based on his meeting with the FSMB, he will participate in a work group to help develop policy on physician's re-entry into practice after an extended period (e.g., retire, health reasons, return to USA, etc.), with the aim to have a policy by mid-2024. The FSMB is currently considering a re-entry program if a physician has not been out-of-practice for 3 years or more. Dr. Alfred offered some examples as to why the length of time for being out-of-practiced should be re-considered. Dr. Berg stated that he would inform the work group, however, he stated that the FSMB is addressing the issue to determine a uniform policy to apply for all states and jurisdictions. He also stated that he will continue to work with TN on developing a Licensed Professional Impairment Program. The name of the program is also being considered. He stated that the Board should consider sending a communique to physicians that self-reporting would not have a detrimental impact on their record or be punitive and that the information would remain confidential. CMEs 2021-2023: Although CEUs were completed in the required calendar years; they were not completed within a 24-month timeframe. Provide Certificates that state what the CME credit is, or the number of CUE credits awarded; therefore, the actual CME certificates would need to be provided. NOTE: The Chair requested that the HPLO take the above comments into account when reviewing the applications for completeness.
