	J. Almoguea stated that the applicant had initially applied as a registered technician, but to be			
	considered certified, they needed to submit their NHA or PTCB certificate. However, if they wanted			
	to proceed with the registered route, they needed to submit 1500 hours, but they had only submitted			
	520. The applicant asked if her W-2s would suffice as proof or whether another completed affidavit			
	was necessary since she has been unable to contact her PIC to sign-off on her hours. A. Mariano			
	stated that a W-2 does not provide evidence that she obtained experience as a pharmacy technician.			
	The Board noted that the applicant had worked 1315.75 hours at a pharmacy, which, combined with previous work experience, totaled 2045.93 hours. Concerns were raised about the validity of W-2s	ļ		
	as proof of training, emphasizing the importance of the affidavit of completed coursework. It was			
	suggested that the individual could get the affidavit approved by their previous employer.]		
	The conversation also touched upon the individual's certification status with NHA or PTCB,			
	confirming they had not yet taken the test. Considering the situation, the Board suggested that the	:		
	applicant either take a national certification exam or submit additional documentation. The meeting			
	concluded with a decision to allow the individual to submit any relevant documents for
