Dr. Miller reported that Mr. Koo had informed the GBAHE that he was licensed in CA; however, the Chair stated he has yet to provide a copy of his license. Upon further research, the Chair reported that he is not listed in the CA system. To date, the procured attorney at the time (Visosky) has not provided any information regarding the complaint; last contact was in December 2022. Z. Pecina subsequently reported that the case was transferred to Asst AG Finney, OAG. Dr. Miller reported that numerous videos on their services were posted on-line by LeBalance even though it is not licensed to perform the services, i.e., acupuncture, chiropractic, and physical therapy. The Chair reported that the complaint still needs to be investigated by the Board. In addition, she stated that a Guam Police officer is allegedly providing the services but is not licensed. The Chair stated that she has informed the Chief of Police. Asst AG Morris will contact Atty Finney to get more information on the case. He also described the options and processes once a lawsuit is filed (temporary restraining order, preliminary injunction and a permanent injunction) with additional information that support the merits of the complaint. If the individual failed to comply with a cease-and-desist order, Asst AG Morris stated that injunctive relief and statutory remedies could be imposed for unauthorized practice.
