Additionally, the representatives acknowledged the existence of an open case with the C tlifornia Board of Pharmacy but emphasized that their license was renewed and remains in good standing, with a forthcoming inspection scheduled for early August. They offered to share their detailed response to the California accusations for the board's review. It response to questions regarding FDA oversight, the company provided a timeline of past inspections, including a 2019 warning letter and a series of inspections spanning from 2017 to 2024. They indicated that they have responded diligently to all inspection findings, including five updates submitted following the most recent inspection, and plan to send another update by the et d of the month. Notably, they reported a reduction in FDA observations from thirteen in 2021 to five in 2024, with no repeat findings, which they attributed to improvements in their quality system and facility. While they confirmed that FDA feedback is typically limited to acknowledgment of receipt, they anticipate a follow-up inspection in April 2026 and continue to pursue a closure of the 2019 warning letter.  When asked about their facility operations, the company clarified that they operate a single compounding and shipping facility in Ledgewood, New Jersey, with analytical testing conducted at a separate lab in Nashville. Concerns regarding the shipment of refrigerated compounded products to Guam were addressed by explaining that only three out of forty-six products require refrigeration and are shipped using validated thermal packaging with ice packs. The company expressed willingness to conduct specific shipping studies to ensure product integrity given Guam's extended transit times.  The board members expressed appreciation for the company's transparency and commitment to regulatory compliance but noted a preference to wait for the outcomes of the upcoming.
