other athletes, or watching other athletes' experiences throughout my life, that my time will come too when I'm asked to pass the torch on to somebody," he said. "So I'm doing as much as I can. People think that I'm taking some risks, but I feel that there is this tiny window of opportunity that I need to jump through because then five years from now I could be like, 'Hey, I feel like fighting this weekend.' And it's gone, it's over. When I hit 40 there's no way that I want to put my body at risk anymore.

"You know, I know every time I go out there, I'm risking my life and my future. So this window that I have, I'm not going to have very much longer, so I'm doing everything I possibly can.

So that when I look back, I have no regrets. And I don't think that I had one."

Ambrose said that lately, more so than any other time in his life, he gets random people, old and young, coming up to him, offering congratulations and other words of encouragement.

"I can't tell you enough how much that means to be, you know, coming from a small town," he said. "Like, I didn't have a whole lot going for me when I was younger, but I feel so much support and love that I never felt at any other time in my life."
