In the fourth set, St. John's middle blockers Knessa Davis and senior Wendy Zheng came alive. Davis put a block on most hits at the net and Zheng connected on medium quick sets from Cyerra Lauron in the middle. Zheng had some epic battles with the Cougars' Gabi Mata and Natasha Kelly at the net and all got their share of points in exciting fashion, but the Cougars came out on top.

In the fifth and deciding set, the teams battled tooth and nail but neither could break away. At 13-13, Hinengi San Nicolas hit a back-row shot after a long

rally to give her team game point. Two service errors only heightened the drama.

In the end, the winner was a back-row shot by Genice Torres who speed-set the ball over the net. Davis got a touch on it, but the ball dropped for the match.

Mata said the championship match against Notre Dame won't be easy.

"Everything is gonna be a fight, just like this game," she said. "We're just gonna have to do our best, and just leave it all on the court."

### Royals win

The Notre Dame High Royals breezed by the Guam High Panthers in straight sets at the Notre Dame gym.

The Royals won 25-9, 25-20, 25-12, with Faith Piper and Cela Langas giving the

Panthers powerful shots through the night.

"It feels good, just knowing that the girls worked hard for this," said Royals assistant coach Noel Sablan. "We practice for it. They just got to execute it in the final game."

Piper said she was excited to advance to the championship game.

"The whole team is thrilled we won," Piper said.

The Panthers crept to within five during the second set, but quick defense and teamwork from Senaiyath Bell, Melissa Blas and Mercedes Cruz kept the Royals in the lead.

Sablan said that the team will be practicing its defense.

"It's what we've been doing since the beginning, ... our defense, serve-serve,

executing the ball for the third contact, getting the points in and never letting the ball hit the ground," he said.

For Piper and the rest of the Royals, it's all about reviewing previous games and improving themselves.

Sablan did have one key piece of advice for the girls.

"Stay humble and fight until the last whistle has been blown on championship day."

The team will face the Academy of Our Lady of Guam Cougars at 7 p.m. Friday at the University of Guam Calvo Field House for the title.
