In the men's division, Camacho, coming off finishing second place during last year's championship, finished first this time.

Camacho shot 77-74-76 for a total 227, nine strokes clear of second-place finisher Eduardo Terlaje, who shot 82-76-78-236. Ivan Sablan, who shared the lead on Day 1 and was in second place after Day 2, finished 77-78-82-237 and slipped to third place.



"It feels really good, very satisfying. I had no trouble holes today, no big numbers, which was nice," Camacho said.

Camacho had three birdies on the final day, on holes 3, 7 and 10. He enjoyed his best round Sunday with four birdies.

"I think it was taking the time on every shot, staying in the moment, focusing on the shot at hand and not really thinking about the end result," Camacho said.

Top golfer Louie Sunga, who challenged Camacho up until the final hole last year, was traveling the first two days of the tournament and recorded only a Day 3 score of 75, with three hirdies.
