livestream. It was like they were more interested than I was. Then everything happened at once."

She felt herself lifted off the ground, then leading a parade of super strong women around the gym, showered with congratulations and cheers.

"I felt really relieved and accomplished. Especially considering the two weeks leading up to the event were so stressful," she said.

Final exams, cutting weight and an uncalibrated scale made her worry even up to the night before weigh-ins.

"But everything worked

out. I feel really blessed and honored," she said.

Former Olympian Edgar Molinos, Guam's national team coach, was more than proud of Santos because he watched how hard she and the other lifters worked.
