

double bogey, double bogey, triple bogey in his next three holes. Meanwhile, Sunga birdied the par 4 No. 4 in the middle of Sablan's meltdown, and when Sunga shot birdie on No. 7, he closed the lead to a single stroke.

There was no way that the Ivan Sablan of 2022 would have recovered from that three-hole binge, he admits. But the 2023 Ivan Sablan has learned how to release his errors, stay calm and play the ball in front of him.

"I gave up a lot of strokes and Louie capitalized on that because he's a great player, one of the best Guam's ever had," said Sablan. "I learned how to handle pressure and don't give up, no matter how bad it is, how bad you're hitting it, you can't give up. You have to keep fighting and that's the biggest lesson I learned."

A double bogey on No. 15 pushed Sablan into the 80s, Sunga managed another birdie on the back nine and Sablan kept his composure to regain a 3-stroke lead. His last stroke was a long putt from near the edge of the green that went in for par.

"My ball striking was working really well, my driver and putter were leaving me behind," said Sunga.

"It was windy, I had to adjust for that but I gotta give it up to Ivan, he played solid. He kept it together on the back."

Finishing in third place was Markus Nanpei, who

opened with 81-83 before shooting the best round of the tournament, an even-par 72 from the tips, which measure more than 7,400 yards.

Defending men's champion Redge Camacho al-

most shot himself out of contention on Day 1, when he took 18 strokes to finish holes No. 13-14 for an 86 round. But his game returned with three birdies in the second round and four in the final, to also finish at

236 total.

Nalapon Vongjalorn finished with a 240 for fourth place.
