In addition, the applicant's license has expired and he failed several exams in the past. The applicant stated that he accomplished more than the 740 hours reported, however, his instructor had passed away; therefore, the hours performed were not officially and correctly recorded.</p> <p>b. 	<p>meet the minimum required hours. Therefore, she requested that the applicant resolve the alleged discrepancy with the school. In addition, the applicant stated that the Board should be able to apply the “grandfather” clause in the law, which should permit approval of his application.</p> <p>d. J. Blas stated that, it is his understanding, that since the GBBC had previously approved an apprentice license for barbering and he has been an apprentice for years, the applicant is requesting the opportunity to test.</p> <p>e. R. Garcia-Santos stated that the applicant does not meet the minimum required hours; therefore, he would have to go back to school or resolve the discrepancy with the school.</p> <p>f. Marcy stated that the last time the grandfather clause was applied was in 1985; however, in the applicant’s case all he had to do was pass the exam, which he failed to do so. In addition, she stated that, since the applicant is applying for cosmetology, he would also have to take the practical and written examinations for cosmetology. R. Garcia-Santos stated that the applicant still did not meet the minimum required number of hours for cosmetology.</p> <p>g. J. Blas reiterated his position that, based on past decisions of the Board, the applicant should be allowed to take the test. If looking at the applications on a case-by-case basis then the Board could make an exception, such as allowing the applicant to take CEUs prior to authorizing an examination.</p> <p>h. The Chair stated that she would be willing to support authorization to take the exam; however, she would not agree to authorizing an apprentice license until the required hours are submitted. R. Garcia-Santos stated that he could agree to the foregoing suggestion, and, if the required number of hours is met, he would be willing to approve the examination and apprentice license.</p> <p>i. The applicant admitted that he is still working with an expired apprentice license for barbering. In addition, he admitted to performing cosmetology tasks. Based on the foregoing, statement, the Chair informed that applicant that he is violating the law.</p> <p>j. The Chair recommended that the applicant stick with barbering in lieu of changing to cosmetology, so if he would pass the examination his apprentice license could be approved. She further stated that the applicant is allowed only a limited number of times to take the retake the exam and within a certain amount of time, to include an opportunity to take refresher courses.</p> <p>k. R. Garcia-Santos suggested the Board table his application so that he would not have to reapply.</p>

Blas stated that this situation is like the previous Board's discussion, where previous Board's had allowed leniency of the procedures; therefore, he suggested that the applicant be allowed to take the exam since there are many others, who have been in the same situation and allowed to continue to retake the exams without any consequences. However, the Board should advise him of the consequences should he fail again. He suggested that the Board clean-up to procedures, moving forward.</p>

In this case, HPLO will extend the expiration date (6 months) in the event the applicant has applied. The Chair stated that she recollects that this foregoing practice was allowed during the pandemic; however, this is not the normal practice. Therefore, J. Blas recommended that a procedure be established to track the number and outcome of examinations, so that the statute could be implemented correctly, e.g., applicant to take refresher course, etc. R. Garcia-Santos recommended that the application be amended to request the applicant to specify the number of times they have taken the test. The Board reviewed the following applications. The Board determined that, if the applicants apprentice certificate expired, they could take the re-examination; however, their apprentice would not be approved. In response to a question from Loren Abrahamsen, Asst AG Finney responded citing the mandate. In addition, the Apprentice certificate could only be extended for three months. The Chair discussed several scenarios, however, the applicants are given ample time to take the exams within the required timeframe.</p>

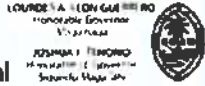
