First, a two-by-two passport photo will now be required for all renewal applications. Second, the notary requirement on renewal applications is being removed, replaced by an attestation on the application. These changes will be effective starting June 3rd, and a memo outlining these changes has been created and sent to all licensees. The updated requirements will be reflected in all renewal applications, and the relevant citation will be 10GCA. 		HPLO	Noted

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Board will no longer issue physical license cards. Instead, an electronic copy in the form of a certificate will be provided. This certificate will include the licensee's information and photo at the bottom. An update on the remote testing probe was provided, indicating that the contract is close to being finalized. Initially targeted for May, the remote testing schedule has been delayed to June due to practical and written test rescheduling. The goal is to have the contract signed this week, after which the Board will decide whether to conduct both theory and practical tests online or just the theory online with practical tests in person. Further details, including the schedule and cost, will be reported at the next Board meeting. It was noted that Ethics training must be completed by May 30, 2024. Members who have not yet taken the course are reminded to do so by the end of the month. Additionally, new members should be informed about this requirement.

VI	<p>OLD BUSINESS</p> <p>A. Rules and Regulations. The Chair addressed the process to update the Board's rules and regulations. The Board confirmed their intent to move forward with this initiative. It was noted that part of the process would include scheduling and conducting a public hearing to gather input and feedback.</p> <p>B. Complaints</p> <p>1. GBBC-CO-2024-0001 – Date Received: 01/16/2024.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Board member initiated a discussion about a complaint received on January 16, 2024. Mr. Blas was invited to provide more insight regarding the incident. The Board inquired about an incident involving a client on October 14, 2023. It was noted that Mr. Blas had been performing hands-on work on clients prior to receiving approval for an apprenticeship, which was granted in December 2023, two months after the incident. The Board questioned Mr. Blas about working without an approved apprenticeship permit. Mr. Blas confirmed working on clients before the permit approval and mentioned being encouraged to do so by the supervisor, Mr. Sapp, despite not having the necessary permit. The Board emphasized that working without a permit was a serious issue and would require further deliberation. The Board informed Mr. Blas that they would discuss the matter further and provide a recommendation regarding the permit. Mr. Blas was advised to refrain from working in any salon until the Board's decision was finalized. The meeting concluded with the Board thanking Mr. Blas for his time and input, assuring him that the matter would be addressed promptly. The Board continued to deliberate on the complaint now that they had gathered more information. They acknowledged the previous recommendations made during the last 	GBBC	0916	On-going

	<p>meeting and discussed the involvement of Mr. Blas. The Board members expressed their views on the responsibility of supervisors to provide proper guidance and ensure compliance with regulations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The discussion emphasized that once a supervisor signs an agreement, they are responsible for ensuring that the apprentice is fully informed and compliant with all requirements. The Board noted that Mr. Sapp, as Mr. Blas's supervisor, should have known and communicated that Mr. Blas could not work on clients without an approved apprentice permit. There was a consensus that Mr. Blas might have been misled and misinformed at the beginning of his career. The Board agreed that penalizing Mr. Blas at this stage would be unfair, given that the establishment should have ensured compliance with the regulations. They highlighted the importance of the establishment's awareness and adherence to what is allowed within their premises. The Board considered voting on the matter, debating whether Mr. Blas should be allowed to continue working under supervision without immediate penalties. The focus was on ensuring that future apprentices are correctly guided and informed from the start. The Complainant stated that she felt it was the establishment's responsibility to ensure personnel are authorized to work in accordance with their licenser status. Ultimately, the Board proposed allowing Mr. Blas to continue his work as an apprentice while ensuring the establishment is aware of and follows all regulatory requirements. The complaint lacked the full name of the licensed individual involved, necessitating further investigation. The next step discussed was to contact the establishment owner listed in the complaint to help identify the individual in question. Since the license number wasn't provided due to the incomplete name, efforts were made to obtain it from the establishment's records. If unsuccessful, the establishment owner would be invited to the next meeting for clarification. The Board emphasized the importance of gathering more information on the licensed individual involved. Given the nature of the complaint, which raised concerns about tools and sanitation, the Board proposed involving the Department of Public Health & Social Services. It was suggested that a representative from the CDH (Communicable Disease and Health) division be present at the next meeting to address the sanitation issues raised in the complaint.
