VIII. Old Business	<p>A. The Practice Act Revision (TPA) – On-going Discussion</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Asst AG Weinberg sent revisions in legal format to the Board for review, with mandate and Rules and Regulations attached. Chairperson found a couple errors and will wait to discuss with him. Board has to provide a fee schedule for infractions. - Some other State Boards announce upcoming rule changes. A concern is for other Optometrists to be aware of the rule changes, so it's not a surprise. Board understands there cannot be advancement until laws are passed, but there will be a grace period for other optometrists to get the new rules. - Asst AG Weinberg summarized the following process: when the Board is ready with the final draft, they are required to hold a public hearing for comments, which is considered and voted upon; the Board could decide to meet with stakeholders beforehand; afterwards, the rules will undergo a legal review by the OAG, which will be assigned to Asst AG Weinberg making sure it conforms with the law. In addition, there are other requirements, e.g. Economic Impact Statement or other required documents. Following AG approval, it will go to the Governor for signature, as to matters of policy. After the Governor approval, it will be provided to the Legislature and Senator Therese Terlaje will schedule another hearing within 75 days of filing, at which time the public provides comment to object or support, prior to the Legislative vote. If ratified, then the new Rules and Regulations become effective; otherwise, then Asst AG Weinberg will have to apply to the Secretary for Certification that they had a hearing and then they are effective by operation of law. - For the infractions, the Board is supposed to come up with penalties. Asst AG Weinberg has a disciplinary matrix that could be used as a framework for progressive discipline of employees. - Asst AG Weinberg suggested more work sessions to finalize and ensure the Board is on the same page regarding the Rules and Regulations. Work Sessions will be coordinated with the Board and Asst AG Weinberg. <p>B.
