NOAA Fisheries to Host Public Hearings on Proposed Endangered Species Act Listings for Giant Clams

NOAA Fisheries is seeking comments on their proposal to list five species of giant clams as endangered and live species of giant clams as threatened under the Endangered Species Act. In addition to the listing determinations, the proposed rule includes specific protective regulations for the five species that are proposed to be listed as threatened.

On Tuesday, September 17th, NOAA Fisheries is hosting an informational meeting and public hearing in Guam at Pacific Islands Club. The informational meeting will begin at 6:00 pm with a brief presentation by NOAA Fisheries, followed by a question and answer session during which members of the public may ask clarifying questions about the proposed rule. The public hearing will begin at 7:00 pm, when members of the public will have the opportunity to provide oral comments on the record regarding the proposed listing determination. Doors open at 5:30 pm.
