Kim questioned the board's authority to inspect or service these machines, noting that they appeared outdated, dirty, or faded, which could result in applicants being unfairly denied licensure. J. The Missile Defense Agency invites you to participate in the Draft Environmental Impact Statement Process for the Enhanced Integrated Air and Missile Defense System on Guam

The Missile Defense Agency (MDA) in cooperation with the United States (U.S.) Air Force, U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, and the Federal Aviation Administration has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Enhanced Integrated Air and Missile Defense (EIAMD) System on Guam. The Draft EIS includes an analysis of the potential environmental impacts that may result from the proposed construction, deployment, and operations and maintenance of the EIAMD system to defend Guam against advanced missile threats (Proposed Action). Mitigation measures that if employed could avoid, minimize, or mitigate potential environmental impacts of the Proposed Action are also analyzed in the Draft EIS.

**Public Involvement Opportunity**

The MDA and cooperating agencies will hold three in-person public meetings. The meetings will be in an open-house format and will include poster stations staffed by project representatives who can provide information and answer questions about the Proposed Action and the findings of the Draft EIS. Arrive at any time between the hours below as there will not be a presentation or formal oral comment session.
