Medical Director's Report USNH: Dr Wescott reported that USNH recently had their base radio repaired that has been down for many years, part of this is for GFD to do radio check with us. C. Mateo from E911 GFD will include base with their radio checks. Dr. Westcott stressed that JRM and GFD had a standard operating procedure approved for mutual aid calls, it has been approved for a few months, and Dr. Westcott wants to confirm if the SOP guidelines have been pushed out to the individuals. SOP outlines can transition to care, so when JRM and Fed fire takes over for a call there is a procedure we go through to insure there is no lapse in care, same goes with GFD to push to their individuals. We have been approved as a NAEMT – PHTLS and TECC course site, we had our inaugural courses we talk to our Federal Fire employees at JRM, currently there is no funding to extend this to GFD, and However Dr. Westcott is looking for funding sources. There are some grants for homeland security that she is looking at and a few other places to get some money to extend these courses to GFD. Dr. Westcott has come across a few cases recently where there are multi departmental interdisciplinary prehospital responses, Guam Fire Rescue, HSC 25, Coast Guard and JRM Federal Fire working on calls together we can established a forum for doing a morbidity and mortality type of review for those kinds of cases. Dr. Westcott asked if any of the agencies have done this kind of cases or if there is a way to formalize the feedback to do case review for interdepartmental and interdisciplinary calls. C. Mateo responded for GFD they do not have anything in line of morbidity and mortality, if there is a coordinated response regarding GFR, GFD, HSC 25 and Coast Guard, that is ideally Guam fire rescue and Coast Guard led, they are very routine on those types of reviews.
