	During the discussion, Dr. Miller expressed concern that several of the listed complaints appear to be procedural in nature—such as potential violations of open meeting laws—rather than cases involving conduct that could endanger patients. Dr. Miller emphasized that the board retains the authority to review and address such complaints independently, without necessarily relying on prolonged legal consultation. He pointed out that securing legal counsel through procurement could result in significant delays, and noted that previous requests to the AG's office had not received timely responses. Dr. Miller also raised transparency concerns, stating that most board members, aside from the assigned investigators, lack detailed knowledge of the complaints. He suggested that complaints might be considered public records and questioned the current level of access provided to board members.			
	In response to Dr. Miller's comments, B. Sablan clarified that the investigation and the complaint itself are not considered public records. Dr. Miller had previously misunderstood, thinking only the identity of the complainant could be kept confidential, while the complaint itself could be public. However, it was explained that, during a public meeting, general information about the

	complaint can be discussed, but the specifics of the investigation and complaint remain confidential in order to ensure due process for both the licensee and the complainant.  In the discussion, B. Sablan acknowledged that some complaints may seem trivial and could be addressed directly at the board level for a resolution, rather than waiting for legal intervention or assistance from the AG's office, which could lead to unnecessary delays. She agreed on the need for the board to efficiently process complaints and come to conclusions. To ensure a thorough process, B. Sablan noted that investigators are working closely with the board and following established SOPs to manage complaints effectively. The board has the authority to make decisions on these complaints, and when investigators present their findings, those will be discussed in public meetings to provide transparency and a clearer understanding for board members. Additionally, she outlined ongoing efforts to procure legal counsel and work with an MOU with the OAG, with the goal of addressing a significant number of complaints in the upcoming board meeting. The importance of ensuring compliance with local and federal laws when considering recommended sanctions was also emphasized. It was expressed that the goal is to address the majority of the complaints in the upcoming board meeting.  Dr. Harper added that for the complaints under investigation, the process primarily involves gathering and verifying the information submitted, as well as obtaining a response from the individual the complaint is against. Legal input is not required for most of these cases, as the

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Guam Public Utilities Commission [PUC] will conduct a public hearing concerning GSWA's Petition to increase rates for FY2026. GSWA proposes to increase rates to fund certain obligations and other expenses of the Authority.

However, whether rates will be increased, or the amount of any such increase, is subject to the recommendation of the PUC Consultants, stipulation of the parties/rate hearing before the Administrative Law Judge, and final review and approval by the PUC Commissioners.
