



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

FY2025 Nine (\$9,000,000.00) Million Appropriation

FY2025 Nine (\$9,000,000) Million Appropriation

In FY2025 the CHamoru Land Trust Commission Survey and Infrastructure Fund was appropriated Nine Million (\$9,000,000) Dollars. The Survey and Infrastructure Fund is a Special Fund that was created through the enactment of Public Law 33-90 and codified into \$75A124, Chapter 75 & 75A, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated. The expenditures of the SIF are restricted to the following:

- 1. For the subdivision, surveying, mapping, and registration of tracts of residential and agricultural land in the CLTC property inventory; and
- 2. For the construction of infrastructure, to include access roads, water, and power utilities, to service CLTC residential and agricultural tracts of land.

C. Summary:

On May 22, 2025, the CLTC Board approved eleven (11) Tracts/Lots, to allocate the Nine Million (\$9,000,000) FY 2025 Appropriation. Collectively, CLTC staff had selected a total of six (6) of the eleven (11) Tracts/Lots for the board's acceptance and approval to grant the Acting Administrative Director to execute the necessary contracts to commence and complete the proposed projects.

D. Explanation:

The six tracts of land will benefit a total of 605 lessees and will provide a vital solution for 251 lessees who hold leases on properties that are unusable due to non-compliance with minimum lot size requirements over the northern aquifers, where no sewer system is available.

Additionally, the proposed projects will ensure that the initial investment yields cost benefits for future infrastructure planning for the adjacent CLTC properties. For example, Tract 1113 in Dededo is located next to Tract 1022, which was originally designated for the Land for the Landless program. The lots within Tract 1022 were surveyed at approximately 474 square meters. However, because they do not meet the minimum lot size requirements, lessees in Tract

1022 have been unable to fully enjoy the benefits of their leased properties without consolidating lots.

Moreover, a quote received about three years ago indicated that the cost to install water and sewer services in Tract 1022 would exceed \$50 million. However, if the Board considers installing water and sewer infrastructure in Tract 1113, it could significantly reduce the overall costs of these services for Tract 1022. Creating new lots will also allow the CLTC to relocate lessees and address the deficiencies present in Tract 1022.

Furthermore, the recent fire at an illegal dumpsite within Tract 1022 has raised environmental concerns that could affect nearby water wells. Correcting these deficiencies will not only enable lessees to fully benefit from their leased properties but will also help reduce illegal dumping and prevent potential environmental issues related to contaminants that could impact the water wells in the vicinity.

E. Board Consideration:

Authorize the CLTC Administrative Director to enter into the necessary agreements with the Department of Land Management, Guam Waterworks Authority, and Guam Power Authority in order to execute each of the various components of the plan proposed here. Further, the Administrative Director is authorized to expend up to \$25,000 from the Survey and Infrastructure Fund and sign such agreements as may be necessary to complete any particular aspect of the plan. Any expenditure of more than \$25,000 from the Survey and Infrastructure Fund shall be considered and approved by the CLTC Board. Finally, the Administrative Director shall report on the execution of this plan as part of his Director's Report at all subsequent CLTC Board meetings.

Project: Water and Sewer Infrastructure Cost Estimates

Location: Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) Tract 1022 (formerly Lot 10125), Dededo

Date: September 10, 2021




Figure 1. Location and utility map.




Figure 2. CLTC re-subdivision survey map of Tract 1022 (formerly Lot 10125).




Figure 3. CLTC subdivision master plan of Tract 1022 (formerly Lot 10125).

Cost estimates for water and sewer infrastructure to serve CLTC Tract 1022 are identified in this document. Figure 1 contains a location and utility map. The estimates are based on CLTC's property maps (Figures 2 and 3), which identify 421 quarter-acre lots intended for residential development.

General Considerations

- (1) Quarter-acre residential lots will require a connection to the public sewer system.
- (2) Septic tanks and leaching fields are not allowed within 300 feet of a water well. Water well D-25 is located on Tract 1022. Tract 1022 needs to have public sewer infrastructure in order to accommodate residential construction near this well.
- (3) The development is within the zone of the Northern Guam Lens Aquifer (NGLA) that is ideal for well development, and needs to be protected as per the Guam Drinking Water Source Assessment and Protection Program and Wellhead Protection Plan. The water wells on Swamp Road and near Tract 1022 currently have maximum nitrate-nitrogen concentrations below 5 mg/L (less than half of the Safe Drinking Water maximum contaminant level of 10 mg/L). Development near these wells should be connected to the public sewer system to protect the public water supply.
- (4) Public water and sewer infrastructure must be constructed on public rights of way or easements.
- (5) Infrastructure planning should include future development from neighboring properties, including CLTC properties.

(6) Estimated unit costs include design, construction management, and construction costs, unless otherwise noted.

Water System

- (1) Water demand calculations assume 421 lots at 600 gpd per household per Hawaii Standards.
- (2) The development is within the zone of the NGLA that is ideal for well development, and GWA will require two additional wells within the development area for water production, at 1/4-acre lots each. See Figure 3.
- (3) Water mains from Wells D-25 and D-26 are located on Tract 1022, through the proposed development. GWA will need at a minimum 20-foot wide utility easement for the current water main. If an easement is not provided, then the cost to relocate the water mains onto the proposed right of way will need to be added into the total infrastructure cost.
- (4) Water system cost estimates are listed in the table below.

Sewer System

- (1) Sewer load estimates assume 90% of water demand for design average flow.
- (2) Pipe size estimates account for possible surrounding future tributary development with an ultimate build-out of approximately 5,000 residential lots, which include CLTC property. Available ground elevation data indicate gravity sewer flow is attainable. Surveyed elevations are required for the sewer design.
- (3) A new sewer main is required along Swamp Road, from Tract 1022 to Route 3. Options for connection to the existing sewer system are described below.
 - Option A: From Swamp southwest on a frontage road (where the military fuel pipeline is located), to the intersection of Route 3 and Okkodo High School driveway (see Figure 4).

Modeling results indicate that a new sewer main connection to the 18-inch sewer line on Route 3 by Okkodo High School can accommodate 421 homes on Tract 1022.

This will direct wastewater to the Southern Link Pump Station, which can accommodate wastewater loading from Tract 1022. However, as additional development is connected to the new sewer main, upgrades to the existing Route 3 gravity sewer and Southern Link Pump Station will be required.

Option B: An alternate connection would be from the end of Swamp Road turning northwest, crossing Route 3, along a public right-of-way, then connecting to a 42-inch sewer line. Coordination with the military and acquisition of a public easement on private property may be required (see Figure 4). This alternate route would require trenchless technology tunnel boring under Route 3 to avoid utility conflicts and damage to the newly-paved road. This cost varies widely depending on many factors including selected technology, ground conditions, soil type, groundwater level, faults, total distance, construction options, etc. including cost escalation to reflect that on Guam. A conservatively low estimate would be around \$2,000 per linear foot.

Initial modeling results indicate that the existing 42-inch diameter sewer can accommodate the full build-out load. Additional modeling is required to evaluate the future military sewer load with the future private development and CLTC sewer load.



Water and Sewer Infrastructure Cost Estimates

Location:

Chamorro Land Trust Comission (CLTC) Tract 1113, Block 16, Dededo

Date:




Figure 1. Location and utility map




Figure 2. CLTC Proposed Subdivision for Tract 1113, Block 16

Cost estimates estimates for water and sewer infrastructure to serve CLTC Tract 1113, Block 16, are identified in this document. Figure 1 shows the location and utility map of the combined subject lots. The estimates are based on CLTC's proposed subdivision schematic shown on Figure 2, which identify 71 lots intended for residential development. No certified surveyed map was provided to GWA by CLTC to identify right of way lengths, widths, or lot elevations.

General Considerations

- (1) Residential lots will require a connection to the public sewer system.
- (2) The development is within the zone of the Northern Guam Lens Aquifer (NGLA) that ideal for well development and needs to be protected as per the Guam Drinking Water Source Assessment and Protection Program and Wellhead Protection Plan.
- (3) Public sewer infrastructure must be constructed on public rights of way or easements.
- (4) Infrastructure planning should include future development from neighboring properties, including CLTC properties.
- (5) Surveyed right of way dimensions and elevations are needed to provide more detailed estimate, including a determination if a sewer pump station is needed. A new pump station will cost about \$2,000,000.00.
- (6) The available capacity of the downstream sewer system will need to be determined. If the available capacity is not sufficient to accommodate the proposed development on the subject lots, then the downstream sewer system will need to be upgraded.
- (7) Estimated unit costs include designs, construction management, and construction costs, unless otherwise noted.

Water System

- (1) Water demand calculations assume 71 lots at 600 gpd per household per Hawaii Standards.
- (2) Additional wells need to be established.
- (3) The surrounding residents near the wells need to consider the shorter contact time of chloride concentration. A minimum time duration is needed for effective disinfection of the water, before reaching the households.
- (4) Water system cost estimates are listed in the table below.


