### REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about August 27, 2025, the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) will request the release of Housing Trust Fund (HTF) funds from the Director of the Office of Community Planning and Development, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Hawaii State Office - Pacific/Hawaii Region. These funds, made available under the Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA) of 2008 (42 U.S.C. § 4501), will be used to support the Rehabilitation of Affordable Rental Units project.

The proposed activity is categorically excluded from National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements under 24 CFR Part 58 of HUD regulations. The Environmental Review Record (ERR) for this project is available for review at GHURA's Main Office, located at 117 Bien Venida Avenue, Sinajana, Guam. The ERR can be examined or copied during regular business hours, Monday through Friday, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays.

### PUBLIC COMMENTS

Written comments on the ERR may be submitted to GHURA's Main Office, addressed to Jo Lyn Q. Terlaje, Community Development Division. GHURA will consider all comments received by August 26, 2025, before approving the request for the release of funds.

### ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Government of Guam certifies to the Director of the Office of Community Planning and Development, U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), Hawaii State Office-Pacific/Hawaii Region, that Governor Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero consents to the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts in any action brought to enforce compliance with environmental review responsibilities. This certification affirms that all environmental review obligations have been fulfilled. HUD's approval of this certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws, thereby authorizing GHURA to utilize Program funds.

### OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The Office of Community Planning and Development, U.S. HUD Hawaii State Office-Pacific/Hawaii Region, will accept objections to its release of funds and the Government of Guam's certification for a period of fifteen days following either the anticipated submission date or the actual receipt of the request, whichever is later. Objections will only be considered if they are based on one of the following grounds: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Government of Guam; (b) the Government of Guam failed to follow a required step or make a necessary decision or finding in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process committed funds, incurred costs, or initiated activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 prior to HUD's approval of the release of funds; or (d) another Federal agency, acting under 40 CFR Part 1504, has issued a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory in terms of environmental quality. Objections must be submitted in compliance with the procedures outlined in 24 CFR Part 58, Section 58.76, and should be addressed to the HUD Office of Community Planning and Development, Honolulu Field Office, 1003 Bishop Street, Suite 2100, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, with a copy emailed to [CPDHonolulu@hud.gov](mailto:CPDHonolulu@hud.gov). Potential objectors are advised to contact the office to confirm the actual last day of the objection period.
