Research Matters: Coral reef restoration, biodiversity breakthroughs

A \$20 million cooperative agreement with the National Science Foundation has allowed the University of Guam to conduct research to restore Guam's coral reef ecosystems and establish coral nurseries to replenish corals damaged by rising sea temperatures, sedimentation and pollution.

The funding, known as EPSCoR—the Established Program to Stimulate Competitive Research—began in 2020.

For Guam, protection of coral reefs is directly tied to the economy and well-being of the island. A 2023 federal government report placed the value of Guam's coral reef ecosystem at between \$63.4 million and \$73.6 million annually. Reefs contribute to recreation and tourism, commercial fishing and cultural heritage.

Healthy reefs also serve to physically protect the island by reducing wave energy and coastal flooding.

Bastian Bentlage, PhD, associate professor of bioinformatics, heads the research teams that have collected and analyzed genetic, genomic, oceanographic, and ecological data in Guam and the region. The results of these studies are a deeper understanding of reef ecosystems, including the cellular processes of corals under environmental stress such as rising sea surface temperatures and coastal runoff.

Research publications

This expansion of scientific knowledge in the region has led to several publications and breakthroughs by UOG Marine Lab researchers.

Genomic research conducted by David Combosch, PhD, professor of population genetics, his students, and post-doctoral researchers resulted in the first whole-genome-scale survey of Guam's staghorn coral,



which is commonly used in coral reef restoration.

Their work resulted in the most detailed genetic baseline for any Micronesian coral to date, and is among the first genomic studies designed to guide restoration projects.

Marine Lab faculty supported by the project also conducted studies on the effects of transplantation of corals to new sites.

In coral restoration, coral fragments are often transplanted from a donor site or coral nursery to a reef that has been damaged by bleaching events or disease outbreaks.

This process can be stressful for corals, and the team investigated the effects of transplantation on the beneficial organisms that live in corals. Taking advantage of our ready access to near-shore coral reefs in Guam and state-of-the-art molecular lab facilities at UOG Marine Lab, the team tracked the corals over time to get deeper insights into the cellular-level processes affecting the success of coral restoration.

Biorepository

The grant has also funded the Guam NSF EPSCoR GECCO Biorepository, which consolidates and expands natural history collections of Guam by providing state-of-the-art digitization, imaging, and mapping of local and regional marine plants and animals.

The biorepository serves the community as a library

of marine specimens that scientists and the public can use to learn about the marine species in our waters. Without this baseline, we can miss important information about the health and wellbeing of the ocean that

supports us.

In addition to specimens collected by EPSCoR-funded researchers, donations of specimens have led to the significant growth of the biorepository collections. For example, a private collector recently donated 4,000 shells from the region with many species collected from Guam waters in the 1960s.

The biorepository is partnering with the National Museum of Natural History,

Smithsonian Institution, Washington, D.C., for DNA sequencing of marine organisms. This partnership will be mutually beneficial as the Smithsonian is working on DNA barcoding of marine invertebrates in U.S. waters, which will include marine invertebrate species from Guam waters.

The University of Guam's Office of Research and Sponsored Programs, ORSP, oversees grant acquisition and research initiatives across UOG's nine research centers.
