VI	Nursing Education	University of Indiana Dr. Varghese introduced herself as an education member of the GBNE and an assistant professor at the University of Guam, and extended a formal welcome and appreciation to Dr. K. Kuhn and Susan for their attendance and interest in collaborating with the board to support the expansion of nursing education and the local nursing workforce. She emphasized the importance of full regulatory compliance and presented several critical questions and concerns regarding Indiana University's proposed clinical and educational partnerships in Guam. 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	Dr. Varghese sought clarification on the status of a memorandum of understanding referenced in prior communications, specifically involving GRMC and the VA Hospital, asking whether the agreement had been formally established or was still under development. She then questioned the university's plan for faculty oversight, noting that the board's Article 6 regulations require active supervision by credentialed clinical faculty, not just remote oversight by preceptors. She highlighted the need for Indiana University to align with Guam's specific clinical supervision standards, which mandate direct involvement of clinical faculty with proper credentials. She further inquired about licensure outcomes for students completing the LPN to BSN program, initially asking if they would be issued Indiana state licenses. After clarification was provided that students would test in the state where they reside, she reiterated that if students intended to test in Guam, Indiana State University would need to comply fully with the board's Article 6 requirements regarding curriculum and clinical education, including rotations in specialized areas such as medical-surgical nursing, pediatrics, obstetrics, and mental health. Addressing concerns about clinical site availability, she pointed out that the proposed sites—GRMC and the VA—do not cover all the required clinical areas, as services like pediatrics, obstetrics, and mental health care are provided at separate facilities in Guam. She asked for details about how the university plans to structure its curriculum and secure additional MOUs to ensure that all clinical requirements are met. Finally, Dr. Varghese acknowledged the program's ACEN accreditation and reaffirmed the need for alignment with Guam's curriculum and clinical hour standards, regardless of where students test for licensure. She concluded by inviting other board members to contribute additional questions. Dr. Kuhn from Indiana State University clarified that their engagement with Guam originated not from institutional outreach but from student interest on the island. She explained that their university has already completed all internal preparations to support potential students in Guam and emphasized that they operate under the guidance of their own state's Board of Nursing. She acknowledged that while some states may request specific adaptations, the program cannot always meet those if they conflict with their own regulatory framework. Nonetheless, the program has generally been well received across multiple jurisdictions and internationally, treating clinical education with a capstone approach tailored for students who are already licensed as LPNs. Dr. Kuhn highlighted the strength of their student population, noting that most are experienced at the bedside and praised by preceptors for their clinical comfort and competence. The university relies heavily on clinical placements near students' residences and employs a strong placement team to facilitate this. While simulation can account for up to 50% of clinical training under their state board's allowances, they typically use it less extensively. One example noted was the use of simulation to replace real-world placements in psychiatric nursing, allowing students to gain exposure to complex mental health conditions like PTSD, depression, and schizophrenia through virtual learning platforms. She stressed that Indiana State University will not proceed in Guam without the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners' full support and would refrain from contacting hospitals or other institutions unless authorized. She explained that students like one named Andrea have struggled to access local nursing programs, making an online model a vital option. The average student is in their mid-30s, often with			

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	families and jobs, and thus benefits significantly from flexible, distance-based education. Further details were presented on the program's competitiveness, demographic diversity, and the fact that it is the only fully online LPN-to-BSN program of its kind. Students come from across the United States, and the university has affiliation agreements with numerous healthcare facilities nationwide. Clinical preceptors are typically required to have a minimum of 18 months of experience, and while a bachelor's degree is preferred, it is not mandatory under their state board's rules. Dr. Kuhn elaborated on curriculum structure, noting the recent addition of a pharmacology course and extensive use of platforms like Canvas and Shadow Health for online instruction and skills validation. Each student receives a skills kit for at-home practice, including materials for catheterization, tracheostomy care, and other essential procedures. They also employ telepresence robotics to support remote learning. Finally, she acknowledged that while not every state is currently included in their network—sometimes due to high regulatory costs—their model has proven highly effective, with nearly all graduates securing employment immediately after program completion. The speaker concluded by reaffirming their long-standing involvement with the program and asked whether the information provided helped address some of the board's concerns. Dr. Varghese acknowledged that while some of her questions had been addressed, others remained unresolved. She sought clarification regarding the use of simulation in the Indiana State University program, specifically asking whether clinical experiences for mental health, obstetrics, and pediatrics were conducted entirely through simulation. Dr. Kuhn confirmed this and emphasized the quality and depth of their simulation tools, noting that such methods had proven effective and were well-received by students. she explained that clinical placements in areas such as pediatrics and obstetrics have become increasingly difficult to secure, citing past challenges in Virginia where regulatory changes necessitated face-to-face clinical experiences for those specialties, even for campus-based students. Despite those efforts, the university continues to face difficulties placing students in these fields, leading to a reliance on simulation. Dr. Kuhn reiterated that whether the program moves forward in Guam ultimately depends on the Guam Board of Nurse Examiners' discretion. She expressed a desire for continued dialogue and suggested arranging a direct conversation with Marcy, the program director, who could offer more detailed answers. Due to time zone differences, Dr. Kuhn had opted to attend the meeting in place of Marcy. to respect the board's schedule. In response, Dr. Varghese thanked Dr. K. Kuhn for her participation and invited other board members to pose any additional questions, recognizing the time commitment involved in attending the meeting from a different time zone. Dr. Calalo posed several critical operational questions regarding Indiana State University's program. He began by asking whether students are required to carry malpractice insurance. Dr. Kuhn confirmed that students are indeed insured and that insurance is one of many prerequisites maintained throughout their enrollment. Dr. Calalo also inquired about the university's practice of conducting site visits. It was clarified that the			

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	program does not perform in-person site assessments. Instead, their clinical placement team liaises directly with agencies and nurse educators to evaluate clinical opportunities. The program relies on digital communication and monitoring tools—students must provide timestamped updates upon arrival and departure from clinical sites, submit weekly clinical updates, and maintain open lines of communication with faculty and preceptors throughout the semester. Dr. Kuhn emphasized that this one-to-one preceptor model offers substantial hands-on experience, particularly beneficial given that the students are already practicing LPNs. Questions were also raised about how preceptors are selected. The university uses criteria set by its state Board of Nursing and, despite a recent regulatory change permitting preceptors with zero experience, the university maintains an internal standard requiring at least 18 months of experience. Typically, nurse educators at partner facilities assist in matching students with appropriate preceptors. Preceptors are not obligated to participate but often volunteer, and the university offers certificates and written commendations to support their professional development. Regarding compliance, Dr. Calalo asked about the protocols for drug testing, fingerprinting, and background checks. These were confirmed as mandatory components during student onboarding. In the event of a medication error during clinicals, the university has a formal documentation process in place, with immediate on-site management followed by reporting and internal follow-up. Dr. Calalo then turned to program duration, to which Dr. Kuhn responded that the program is flexible and self-paced. While the fastest path to completion is approximately two and a half years, students can proceed more slowly if needed. A summer session is available but condensed into an 11-week term. He also asked about program outcomes, specifically NCLEX pass rates. Dr. Kuhn confirmed that this data is actively tracked and must meet regulatory standards to maintain accreditation. The program includes a comprehensive NCLEX review course at the end and has consistently demonstrated strong student outcomes. They emphasized the rigor and high standards of the program, noting that many students initially underestimate its difficulty due to its online format. Finally, as Dr. Calalo concluded his line of questioning, G. Woodard began to ask about preceptor compensation, prompting the continuation of the discussion. The discussion addressed whether preceptors are compensated, clarifying that they are not paid and participate voluntarily, with the organization having no authority to compel them to continue if they choose to withdraw. In such cases, a replacement preceptor must be found, which can occasionally cause logistical challenges, though this is rare. The conversation then shifted to comparing board requirements with those of other states, such as Indiana and Oregon, particularly regarding the minimum experience required for preceptors. It was noted that while the board may require more experience, some states have reduced their experience criteria to one year to address difficulty in finding preceptors. The director, Marcy, was suggested as a more appropriate contact for detailed questions on board requirements. Clarification was made distinguishing between preceptors and faculty, highlighting that Guam’s program operates with remote faculty oversight while maintaining close communication and support with on-site preceptors, who are experienced LPNs familiar with hospital practice. The selection criteria for LPN candidates in the program were explained, focusing primarily on GPA in key science courses, years of experience, and educational background, with more points awarded			

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		for longer experience and accredited schooling. The program no longer requires an entrance exam due to its cost and limited benefit. While years of nursing experience are considered, it is weighted alongside other factors such as full-time versus part-time work history, with GPA on the five sciences being the most significant predictor of success in the program. Clarification was provided to G. Woodard regarding the relationship between the nursing program and Indiana University, explaining that the institution itself remains based in Indiana. It was confirmed that other state boards of nursing approve students to take the NCLEX exam through their respective states, or students may choose to test through Indiana since that is where they attended school. Concerns were raised about the perception that Indiana University is establishing a new university on Guam, which led to questions about compliance with Guam's regulations for local universities, such as maintaining passing rates to ensure reaccreditation. The conversation highlighted that faculty overseeing students must be compensated, with the program paying faculty based on student groups, even when students are dispersed geographically and clinical experiences occur across different shifts. It was emphasized that board regulations limit clinical group sizes to no more than ten students, regardless of the format. The challenges of online education were also discussed, noting varying board requirements and the evolving nature of remote learning, alongside the need for caution when considering programs without physical campuses. Reference was made to a recent incident in Florida involving questionable online programs, which heightened board vigilance regarding program legitimacy and student outcomes. Despite initial skepticism about online education, it was acknowledged that such formats can provide valuable opportunities for students who face barriers to traditional classroom attendance. The meeting concluded with a mutual understanding that decisions about program approval rest with the board, while the program expressed interest in exploring options to accommodate requests from potential students in Guam. The board expressed appreciation for this engagement. As the meeting neared its conclusion, Dr. Kuhn made a request to G. Woodard to obtain contact information in order to arrange a follow-up meeting while the discussion remained fresh. It was recommended that further communication be directed to either D. Sulat or B. Sablan at the board office via email to coordinate ongoing dialogue. B. Manzana shared her personal perspective as an LPN who had navigated the challenges of advancing her career while managing family and full-time employment responsibilities. She expressed support for the proposed program, recognizing its potential to offer flexible educational opportunities to similarly situated individuals in Guam. While affirming the need to maintain quality and safety standards in nursing education, she voiced appreciation for the innovative approach and potential impact of Indiana State University's program. In response to a question about the effectiveness of simulation-based training compared to traditional clinical experiences, it was explained that internal research showed no significant performance difference in student outcomes across both methods. In fact, in some cases, students exposed to simulation—especially in scenarios difficult to replicate in clinical settings—performed as well or even better, such as male students in Oman who excelled in OB-GYN knowledge through simulation due to cultural restrictions on direct patient care. Dr. Kuhn also shared their extensive involvement in simulation-based			

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		learning and development of virtual reality training modules using real human actors to enhance learning outcomes. The board agreed that further discussion could be scheduled offline, emphasizing this meeting as an introduction to the potential partnership and what Indiana State University could offer the Guam nursing community. Before the meeting closed, board members addressed a significant procedural issue: the current rules and regulations in Guam make no distinction between traditional and fully online nursing education programs, nor do they address the use of simulation as a primary clinical training method. As such, the board acknowledged that before considering approval—even conditional—for such a program, the existing regulations would need to be updated to incorporate provisions specific to online education. It was suggested that this would require the addition of a new section to the existing articles governing nursing education, possibly under Article 6. Board members emphasized that this effort would demand time, collaboration, and the formation of a dedicated working group. While recognizing the value and innovation such programs may bring, especially in response to the changing landscape of nursing education and workforce needs post-COVID, the board stressed that approval must be grounded in clear regulatory authority. They concluded that further research, collaboration with Indiana State University, and careful revision of the regulatory framework would be essential before moving forward.
