

Upon reviewing the provided item list, it appeared there was a discrepancy between ZimVie's use of the term and the Board's understanding, which aligns biologics with complex biologically manufactured medications, often used in treatments such as cancer therapy. The items submitted by ZimVie seemed to be animal-derived dental products rather than pharmaceuticals requiring strict regulatory oversight. The Board agreed the products were likely standard dental supplies and questioned whether licensing the dental practitioner was sufficient. It was suggested that the Dental Board be consulted for clarification on such supply classifications. Additionally, it was emphasized that ZimVie's activities aligned more with distribution rather than manufacturing, especially as they have no physical establishment on Guam. Therefore, it was recommended that ZimVie apply as a distributor rather than a manufacturer to accurately reflect their intended operations.			Applicant was Recommended to Apply as a Distributor.
		<b>2. IMPRIMIS NJOF, LLC</b> The Board reviewed the application from Imprimis NJOF, LLC, which is applying for licensure as an over-the-counter (OTC) full-scale distributor. It was noted that the company has previously undergone FDA inspections, during which a few issues were observed but have since been addressed. Their operations are based in New Jersey, and they are currently active, with product distribution also connected to California pharmacies. ## Proposed Issuance of Underground Injection Control System Operating Permits for Tasi 17 Association of Apartment Owners

Public Review and Comment Period: May 15, 2025- June 13, 2025

The Guam Environmental Protection Agency (Guam EPA) runs the Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program, as mandated by the Safe Drinking Water Act, and approved by U.S. EPA.

The Agency regulates all applicable activities as set forth in the Guam's UIC Regulations. The UIC Program requires operating permits for all existing injection wells/systems. This includes wells built prior to the approval of the regulations are still in operation, and wells/ systems constructed after the effective date of the regulations.

Guam EPA has received renewal applications from Tasi 17 Association of Apartment Owners for three injection systems located at Tasi 17 Apartment in Upper Tumon. The apartment building has subsurface drainage systems at parking areas.

On the basis of a preliminary UIC requirement review, the Administrator has proposed issuing UIC permits to allow discharges of stormwater runoff into the injection systems.

The discharges contain stormwater runoff only. No industrial discharges or any discharges are allowed into the systems.

The permit for these applications will require:

- 1 - Only stormwater runoff to be discharged into the injection systems
- 2 - Semi-annual monitoring of water quality for MBAS, Oil and Grease, N03-N, Endrin, Lindane, Toxaphene, 2, 4-D, 2, 4, 5-TP Silvex, Heptachlor, Methoxychlor, Lead, Benzene, Ethylbenzene, Xylene, Toluene, MTBE, Boron, COD, and pH;
- 3 - Assurance regarding repairs, replacement, or abandonment of the wells/systems in the event of failure;
- 4 - A laboratory analysis report of runoff water taken from the designated sampling point of the systems; and
- 5 - Compliance with other UIC requirements.

A copy of the Draft Permits and Permits Application for the above applicant and all other supporting documents are available for public inspection from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Water Resources Management Program Section of the Water Division, Guam Environmental Protection Agency, located at 17-3304 Mariner Ave., Tiyan, Barrigada 96913.

If there are no appeals, the Draft Permits become final. Operation of the injection wells/systems identified by the applicant may proceed subject to the conditions of the permits and other applicable legal requirements.

The final decision to set conditions and issue the final permits or deny application for the permits will be decided after all comments have been considered. If no comments are received within the 30-day waiting period, the final permits shall be issued immediately after the commenting period closes.



