"Purebred Jiu-Jitsu's legacy and leadership inspired us from the beginning. The affiliation marks a historic milestone for both organizations, expanding Purebred's reach into Korea while strengthening Dunsan Jiu-litsu's ties to one of the most established academies in the Pacific.

#### Started with knowledge exchange

The relationship between the two academies began in 2016, when Mun and his students first visited Guam

to train and exchange knowledge with the Purebred headquarters.

Although the Sharks tightened up defensively for the remainder of the first quarter, the momentum had already shifted.

GW's second score came courtesy of special teams.

A muffed punt by Sanchez was recovered deep in Sharks territory, setting up Justin Sablan for a short-yardage touchdown run to make it 14-0.

Quarterback Jace Dela Cruz then connected with Colen Ray Salas for a 29yard touchdown strike.

A tipped PAT attempt left the score at 20-0 heading into halftime.

#### Leon Guerrero leads second-half surge

The second half opened full throttle.

On just the fourth play, Tylames Leon Guerrero snagged his second interception of the night and returned it 27 yards for a touchdown.

Dela Cruz continued his efficient night, finishing 4-of-8 for 107 yards and two touchdowns, including a 54-yard bomb to Rayn Rios on a wheel route.

Leon Guerrero added a two-point conversion to stretch the lead to 36-0.

Jayce Sablan capped the scoring with a layard touchdown run, sealing the 42-0 rout.

Unsung heroes shine

While the stat sheet was filled with big plays, the offensive line quietly paved the way for success. Their consistent blocking allowed the Geckos to execute key plays and maintain control throughout the game.

"We started off rough, which was hard," said center Terince Leon Guerrero. "But we kept moving, kept going, and brought up the hype, and just kept pushing through."

Terince Leon Guerrero also emphasized the team's mindset.

"Personally... I don't really care about all the media and everything. [To me], it's just have fun, play football, and play the sport I love. We all love football. and it shows," he added.

With their third straight win, the Geckos continue to prove they're a force to be reckoned with this season. Their next challenge awaits, but for now, GW stands tall-undefeated and unshaken..

On the other sideline, Sanchez head coach Lukas Masnayon is leading a fresh-faced coaching staff of nine, all new to the program. With just five seniors and six juniors, the Sharks are in the midst of a rebuilding phase.

"It was just grip and grind from there. Assignments got more understood as the game progressed, and we saw who were the factors on defense that we needed to block out. That's what created opportunities and holes that running backs couldn't miss. That's what led them to hit the holes harder and read the defense," Masnavon said, reflecting on his team's second-half adjustments.

Now sitting at 1-3, Sanchez's lone win came against Okkodo (19-0), with losses to FD (63-0), Southern (52-16), and GW

Despite the setbacks, Masnayon remains optimistic about the team's growth.

"From the first day of summer to the second half of this season, we've had some major improvement," he said. "Having a new coaching staff was a shock to the kids, it was all new to them, I can't complain about the progress they've made. All a learning process for both teams."

some players out, they gave it their all and played with heart from start to finish."

Fellow senior Noah Harris, the lone star carry over from last season, scored the Panthers' first TD on a 9-yard double reverse in the 2nd quarter that would cut a Southern lead to 7-6.

Harris also came up big on the defensive side with a game-high 7.5 tackles.

"This win means a lot," Harris said. "We started (the season) late, got a lot of (gear) in late, but we work hard to catch up to everybody, and we showed that."

Talented running back Kaden Cruz, who was the workhorse with 99 yards on 21 carries, got the Dolphins on the board first on a five-yard off tackle in the 2nd quarter.

Southern, however. found themselves trailing 12-7 into the final period, but their confidence didn't rush the tempo.

Backup QB Johnnie Brub was brought in with their power package and two strong pushes brought the ball to the Guam High 1-vard line.

But Southern, which is the most penalized team in the league, committed two costly penalties that brought the ball back to the

The Panthers held strong as Rai Johnson intercepted Ghesan Gaje in the end zone on 4th and long.

The Dolphins had one last chance when Mason Calvo recovered a fumble on the ensuing drive.

But Gaje's long pass over

the middle bounced off his receiver and into the hands of Polite, who sprinted down the left side for the game-sealer.

Guam High had five of their plays go for over 30 yards, something Harris credits the raw speed of some of their players.
