VI	Nursing Education	Indiana State University During the meeting, members revisited a prior discussion concerning the implementation of a 100% simulation clinical component and emphasized that progress could not be made without first establishing appropriate rules and regulations. Dr. Varghese noted that no communication had been received from relevant parties, nor had the board reached out, as it was deemed unnecessary in the absence of finalized regulations. G. Woodard questioned the urgency of the matter, pointing out that UOG already operates similar programs, and suggested delaying further action until there is a stronger demand. When asked whether the issue should remain on the agenda, consensus formed around removing it for now and revisiting it during the broader review of Article 6 regulations. 	Report	1. GBNE-CO-20-007/1, 2, 3, 4, 6 & 7 Received 9/16/20. G. Woodard provided an update indicating that an application had been submitted for funding to engage an outside entity to review this case, which would remain on the agenda until either a third-party opinion is received or the statute of limitations expires. Progress was acknowledged to be slow, described as "moving at the speed of government." B. Sablan brought an additional matter before the board regarding complaint number CO20-007-1. It was clarified that the complaint involves unnamed nurses, making it impossible to conduct a proper investigation. G. Woodard gave further clarification and confirmed that while other individuals were identified through a CMS investigation, the individual in number seven, was not identified. Given the lack of identification, He moved to omit complaint number seven from the case, recommending that this portion of the complaint be dropped due to the absence of a named licensee. VIII	Old Business	A. Appointment of Advisory Committee The board engaged in a detailed discussion regarding a proposed advisory initiative intended to support the orientation of newly appointed members. B. Manzana explained that the recommendation stemmed from the reality of board member turnover and emphasized the importance of ensuring continuity. The concept involved having a predecessor, or an experienced former board member, guide the incoming member through the transition process to help them navigate their new responsibilities effectively. This support, she explained, would be temporary and focused on preserving institutional knowledge during transitional periods. M. Gay questioned the need for formal involvement from previous members during official meetings, suggesting that new board members typically learn through direct experience and informal mentorship. B. Manzana shared her personal experience in which her predecessor played a vital role in preparing her for her duties, suggesting that a structured orientation process could be beneficial. 	G. Woodard acknowledged the intent behind the proposal but cautioned that formalizing such a process might create additional administrative burden. He shared that in his own experience, the transition had been informal and dependent on support from executive officers, recognizing that while learning by doing is often necessary, any effort to ease the transition for future members could be worthwhile. B. Manzana agreed that the proposal may not need to take the form of a formal committee or permanent program, but rather serve as a flexible, temporary mechanism for a "warm handoff" between outgoing and incoming members. The board agreed that further consideration was needed to determine the structure and timeline, and they welcomed additional suggestions to refine the initiative and ensure it serves its intended purpose without becoming unnecessarily burdensome. Dr. Varghese expressed appreciation for B. Manzana's initiative but aligned with concerns raised by M. Gay, emphasizing that informal orientation and training are already in place and sufficient. She noted that upon appointment, GBNE and HPLO staff provide ample guidance, including a formal orientation session attended by all board members, which effectively covers foundational responsibilities. While acknowledging the complexity of investigations and disciplinary matters, she stressed that such knowledge is often gained through experience and external training, some of which board members have had the opportunity to attend. Dr. Varghese also voiced practical concerns about the feasibility of acting as an advisor after leaving the board, particularly given the voluntary nature of their service. She advocated instead for a more flexible, informal support system, rather than establishing a standing committee or formal advisory structure. G. Woodard summarized the discussion by acknowledging the intent behind the proposal and recognized the value of easing transitions. However, he noted that the board already engages in such informal mentorship, and form			Noted

		B. Manzana noted that the NCSBN portal provides established pathways and guidelines for addressing impaired providers, which many states follow. She offered to circulate relevant NCSBN materials for the board's review via email. G. Woodard supported this direction, stressing the importance of balancing public safety with compassion for affected licensees, and highlighting the potentially severe personal consequences of punitive-only approaches. The board agreed to revisit the issue in future meetings under old business and expressed intent to further explore implementing a supportive, structured program modeled after NCSBN standards.

"In my 20 plus years of coaching football, John nie stands out as being on a completely different level compared to any other female I've seen play the game at the high school level," coach Cruz added.

After just four games, some of the island's football historians can't remember another female high school player making such a big influence, especially in the short amount of time.

Some phenomenal young players who excelled in the game were names like Aubrey Posadas, Morgan Reyes and Jalana Garcia. but that was in youth football and they didn't play high school ball.

There have been scatters of female players, but far less impactful.

"Johnnie is definitely one of the best athletes in her generation, and she's only getting started," said Olivia Flores Elliott, a true legend of women's tackle football and rugby. "She's a multisport athlete with grit and determination to learn and get better. You don't see that much anymore in athletes nowadays but she is definitely different, I think it speaks volumes of her bravery that she has the confidence to play high school football as a freshman and she's not afraid to tackle and be tackled, size doesn't matter, and she proves that."

Mother's influence

Brubs interest in football started around the age of 4 while watching her mom Raylyn Brub play in the women's tackle football league. The football bug bit hard, even at such a young age, and the yearning for



the gridiron and the nervousness (or lack thereof) that comes with it is inher-

No, I'm not nervous when she plays," said mom Raylyn. "I was excited when she told me she was gonna play in high school."

The attraction to the game seems to go beyond just interest or even love. lt's an addiction.

'Football has taught me a lot'

The 5-foot-4, 140-lb. unicorn doesn't possess an intimidating presence. It's the unseen intangibles that sets her apart from the rest.

"Football has taught me a lot," Brub said. "It's taught me discipline, self-criticism, and self-confidence. Football made me realize that I can do anything if I have the mindset and the positivity for it. Football is addictive. Once you get on that field, you would not want to get off."

Brub made her way through the Packers, Eagles and Outlaws youth organizations for her first four years of action, playing mostly running back and linebacker on those teams.

After a championship season with the Outlaws in 2024, she took the big step of playing with the bigger boys in high school.

'At first, I questioned myself (to play in high school), I'm outsized and out-aged.

But what made me play was the hard work I did throughout my years. Playing football made me realize how capable I was to do anything. Everyone used to tell me I was not good enough to play with boys because I could get hurt, but I didn't let them put me down. I proved that I can take a hit and definitely give one back," she said.

How about the nerves? It's fun, but still a scary sport to play, she said.

'I get scared, definitely. But I use that fear and turn it into power and fire," Brub said.

As for being the only girl on the Southern squad, she puts in the work just like the rest of the guys and earns her playing time.

"It really doesn't make a difference. I do what the boys do. But to me, being the only girl on the team makes me feel like I'm able to go above and beyond, past my limits, and to also help them push past theirs."

Fellow freshman, starting quarterback and team captain Ghesan Gaje is a daily witness to what Brub brings to the team, dating back to last year's Outlaws squad and transitioning to the Dolphins.

"Johnnie is like one of us," Gaje said. "She puts her hard work and dedication into football ever since youth. Everybody knows to watch out for her because she can most like-

ly hit harder than most of the boys on the team. She is fierce ,strong, dedicated and one of the hardest workers on this team."

Bright future

With just a hint of proof so far and the potential of what's to come, plus the "addiction" to the game, Brub has as bright a future as any stud freshman.

Still not quite back to 100% physically due to an injury sustained in youth football, the sky is the limit with a fully-developed and healed Brub.

"I have no doubt she'll get the opportunity to showcase her running back skills-and when she does, she's going to impress," coach Cruz said.

Sights set on the military

As for post high school, she has her sights set on the military. Outside of football, her other interest is with the JROTC program at Southern High.

"Johnnie is a natural gleader," added coach Cruz. leader," added coach of "I couldn't be more proud, as her coach and as her nino, to help guide her toward success off and on the field."

And if one Brub is not uenough, keep your eye out on younger sister Relyn, an 8th-grade rugby standout at Agueda Johnston Middle School waiting in the shadows to show her athletic skills as well.

Bonus: Johnnie's first 🗟 cousin Cole Brub is a big part of the FD Friars defense and their "3 Degrees" offensive power formation. Cole's dad is Chris Brub, a former MMA star, who happens to be the brother > of Johnnie's mom.
