		B. Personal Interviews:			
		1. Sungho Lee During the meeting, the board conducted a comprehensive interview with Dr. S. Lee, who is scheduled to take the dental board exam on October 14 and 15, 2025. The purpose of the discussion was to outline the exam process and clarify expectations. Dr. Rapadas explained that the two-day examination would begin with a lab-focused session, during which Dr. Lee would identify a tooth on a typodont, perform a crown preparation, take impressions, pour the model in stone, wax the crown, and complete the investment. Although casting would not be performed on-site, Dr. Lee was instructed to bring the casted crown the following day for evaluation. Dr. Rapadas emphasized that the final polishing and cement-ready crown must be completed before the start of the clinical component on the second day. Dr. Lee was advised to visit the dental clinic in advance to become familiar with the facilities and equipment, though he is responsible for bringing his own materials. While some lab tools like vacuum spatulators and vibrators would be available, all final casting work must be done at an external lab, such as one affiliated with Dr. T. Lee, whom Dr. S. planned to work with. The second day would be dedicated to clinical procedures and oral diagnosis. Dr. S. Lee was required to perform at least three operative procedures, either on separate patients or combined on one patient, such as a composite and an amalgam restoration. Additionally, they would need to present a complex oral diagnosis case involving	GBED		Noted

		multidisciplinary treatment, complete with x-rays, mounted models, and periodontal charting. Dr. Rapadas outlined specific steps, including ideal preparation, rubber dam placement, decay removal, and restoration evaluation, for both amalgam and composite procedures. An oral diagnosis component requires Dr. Lee to interact with a patient, explain their treatment plan, and demonstrate diagnostic and communication skills. Dr. Rapadas stressed the importance of a well-documented, multidisciplinary case and noted that this part of the exam must be completed by 3:00 PM, after which the board would deliberate on the candidate's performance. While official results would be mailed, candidates could attend the board's discussion to hear preliminary outcomes. Dr. Lee confirmed plans to relocate to Guam and work part-time at Dr. Thomas Lee's office, his spouse is also planning to take the exam in February. The jurisprudence exam, which could be taken prior to the clinical portion, was also discussed. The board advised visiting the HPLO office to take and pass the written test in advance, allowing for multiple attempts if necessary. Dr. Rapadas further clarified that assistants brought to the exam must be licensed in Guam and accompanied by appropriate documentation and waiver forms. In closing, Dr. Rapadas advised Dr. Lee, to select straightforward cases for the exam to avoid unnecessary complications, encouraged consultation with Dr. Lee for additional guidance, and offered ongoing support through the board secretary for any further questions.			
		C. Pro-Ration of C.E. for New Dentist: Dr. Rapadas discussed CE requirements for dental licensure, particularly for new graduates. He confirmed that individuals who graduated from dental school within the past two years may use their dental school education to satisfy the CE requirement for licensure, and are therefore not required to submit documentation of 40 CE hours. 		if the individual was licensed earlier in the current year, so long as their graduation date falls within the two-year window. For applicants who graduated more than two years ago, however, the full 40-hour CE requirement applies, regardless of how recently they became licensed. The board noted that those who fall outside the two-year post-graduation period are typically already licensed and practicing in another jurisdiction and therefore expected to meet standard CE requirements. Additionally, Dr. Rapadas clarified the concept of CE hour prorating, which is only applicable to experienced practitioners who begin practicing in Guam partway through the renewal cycle. In such cases, if a practitioner enters mid-year and passes the exam, the required CE may be reduced from 40 hours to 20 for that cycle. This prorated requirement does not apply to recent graduates, as their eligibility is based strictly on the two-year rule. A specific applicant was discussed briefly, but it was concluded that graduation dates would need to be confirmed before determining CE requirements.

Research Matters: Collaborative conservation across land, sea

University of Guam ORSP

The University of Guam's Cooperative Ecosystem Studies Unit, CESU, is leading the way in environmental research and stewardship through projects that span coral reef monitoring, native plant restoration, endangered species protection, and marine archaeology.

Since 2010, UOG CESU has been part of a national network of more than 300 university and community partners that collaborate with federal agencies to protect natural and cultural resources.

UOG is the only member of this network based in Micronesia and is part of the Hawai'i-Pacific Islands CESU, which opens doors for local scientists to engage in high-impact, federally funded conservation work.

As of 2024, UOG CESU is managing 15 active projects totaling \$13 million in federal grant funding, all administered by Office of Research and Sponsored Programs, ORSP. These projects are carried out by UOG faculty researchers in partnership with Naval Facilities Engineering Systems Command and Joint Region Marianas.

Restoring native forests

At the Center for Island Sustainability and Sea Grant Island Conservation Lab, associate director for natural resources Else Demeulenaere, PhD, leads a \$4 million reforestation project on Department of Defense (now Department of War) lands.

With support from program manager Vince Fabian, the team is removing invasive species like vitex and replanting native trees and shrubs from their on-campus nursery, which currently holds 75 native species.

Thousands of seedlings have been outplanted across

Andersen Air Force Base and Naval Magazine to preserve the diversity of Guam's forests and savanna grasslands.

Safeguarding endangered species

Plants and animals on Guam that are listed under the Endangered Species Act are protected by law. Conservation efforts for endangered plants and animals are carried out to safeguard them and their habitats.

Two UOG CESU projects focus on the propagation and protection of endangered plants native to Guam, including the *Serianthes nelsonii* and rare savanna species. These efforts, also led by Demeulenaere and Vince Fabian's restoration team, involve cultivating seedlings and maintaining outplanted populations on military lands.

In addition, Curt Fiedler, PhD, professor of biology, leads CESU-funded surveys for the endangered Mariana eight-spot butterfly and the cultivation of its host plants, supporting recovery efforts for this rare native species.

Protecting Guam reefs, marine life

UOG Marine Lab is at the forefront of long-term coral reef monitoring. Peter Houk, PhD, professor

of marine biology, leads efforts to track coral health, including bleaching events and disease, at sites around Apra Harbor and other submerged lands managed by the military.

The team is surveying coral and fish populations affected by construction activities on the Glass Breakwater and is compiling the results in a GIS database to inform future marine management practices.

In 2024, the project expanded to include surveys of marine debris and assessments of acute disturbances, such as outbreaks of the crown-of-thorns starfish—a coral-eating predator that can devastate reefs. The team is also actively removing these starfish as part of its reef response efforts.

Supporting this work is Chris Yeo, PhD, of the Water and Environmental Research Institute of the Western Pacific, who is leading water quality monitoring at nearby reef sites and river outputs to provide a fuller picture of reef health.

UOG Sea Grant leads another important marine monitoring effort at Andersen Air Force Base, where it has been leading sea turtle conservation since 2018. UOG researchers conduct regular surveys, protect turtle nests, and track hatchling success at key beaches such as Tarague, Scout, Sirena, and Pati. The program also supports outreach events and school presentations to raise public awareness about sea turtle conservation.

The University of Guam's Office of Research and Sponsored Programs, ORSP, oversees grants acquisition and research initiatives across UOG's nine research centers.
