teammates, and opponents for helping him continue to grow as a player.

He said the common denominator for him at any level or with any team is his attitude, how seriously he takes the game.

"No matter what happens, I'm going to work hard and be a good teammate. My goal [is] to take our college and make the conference tournament," Manibusan said. "It hasn't been done in our program's history."

'Speed of play is quicker'

It has been a major transition, however, even with

his previous accolades.

"The speed of play is quicker," Manibusan said. "The players you play against [are] so much better than the island, but just like everything that I've experienced, [I] have to keep going and take it day-by-day and always try and get better. I knew what I needed to focus on to get better, and hopefully it'll pay off."

Although not a team captain anymore, Manibusan said he is able to contribute to the team "a lot of things not even related to playing soccer itself," and always tries his best to always set an example with the team and show them what is needed to win.

"I would love to be captain of the Cal Poly team, [but] I have to prove myself out here," Manibusan

said. "I'm able to contribute things like bringing energy, having a good attitude, being encouraging my teammates when they make mistakes, or when they just need that encouragement."

He said these contributions are important for any team to have because they are "the things that take no talent," stressing how teams do not need to have talent to be a good team, and "those things are definitely what I'm able to do and bring."

Team bond

Comparing the team culture of the Cal Poly Humboldt Lumberjacks to the brotherhood at FD, Manibusan believes the team's bond will ultimately be its greatest weapon.

"It's different [because]

you have guys from all over the place, from Hawaii, all throughout the West Coast," Manibusan said. "It's definitely interesting how we all come together, [and] some of us were [also] forced to live with each other. It creates this environment that you can't get in high school, because everyone's living with their families and separate. It's definitely a very positive experience."

Manibusan added that for a team to accomplish a goal, every player on the team needs to "buy in to what we're trying to do, and that means keeping hold of the standards that we set every day in practice and on and off the field."

He said all those things

add up to being a top team and a team that is "going to make the conference tournament and win games."

Until his goal is achieved, Manibusan wants to gather as much experience and skills as possible, planning to remain in the mainland for summer 2025 to play for club teams.

"I have aspirations definitely for playing for the Guam senior team, the Matao," Manibusan said. "Hopefully, when there's opportunities for that, whoever the coach is, will be confident enough that I can play at the level. I need to also get to a state where I'm confident that I put in enough work to earn that call up to the senior team."
