		letter to Senator William Parkinson. The first issue involved the definition of emergency contraception in Section 98101B, which referred only to prescription drugs, whereas the board recommended including both prescription and non-prescription medications to reflect current medical practices. The second issue pertained to outdated dosing language that referenced a required follow-up dose, despite modern regimens now being single-dose; the board recommended either updating this language or removing it entirely to prevent inconsistencies with evolving standards. Lastly, M. Gabriel highlighted concerns with the bill’s effective date, as Section 3 indicated immediate enactment. This was deemed impractical for healthcare providers and hospitals, who require additional time for procurement, shipping, and formulary review processes that typically involve pharmacy and therapeutics committee approvals. She emphasized that the implementation timeline did not align with the operational realities of clinical practice and is currently awaiting a response to its submitted feedback.

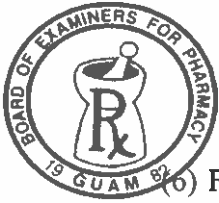
