

As for the competition itself, seven countries were split into two pools for a round robin play from Monday to Wednesday.

Guam is the fourth seed and was put in a pool with Laos, Brunei, and Jordan.

On Monday, Guam fell 1-2 to Jordan in a close matchup.

Mercado stepped up first as the #2 singles. She lost 6-1, 6-0 in a tough match against a strong woman, but played with heart nonetheless.

Gibson had a more favorable outcome as the #1 singles for Guam. She played with precision and power to win an impressive match 6-4, 6-2.

"I enjoy being able to represent Guam year after year and am grateful to be and compete in my position at the BJJC level," Gibson said.

With the singles split, the doubles match became the decider.

Gibson got right back on the court with Oh in a nail-biting match. Both teams played with high intensity, but it was Gibson who shone at the net. After the teams split sets 7-5, 5-7, the outcome came down to a tense tiebreaker.

The crowd cheered for every point, but Guam ultimately fell just short, 9-11, in the final frame.

The following day, Guam rebounded with a hard-earned 2-1 win against Brunei.

Mercado put all her effort out on the court in a long,

grueling singles match but lost in three sets: 7-6, 4-6, 2-6.

"It was a hard fought match, and I'm grateful for the opportunity to represent Guam," Mercado said.

Gibson delivered once again in her singles match, winning 6-1, 6-3 with ease. She took control of the match, hitting shots that flew past her opponent.

Again, it came down to the doubles match. Gibson and Oh struggled to find their rhythm in the first set, but picked it up in the second.

Carrying that momentum into the tiebreak, they closed it out to win 4-6, 6-2, 10-6.

"It's amazing to play at this level for the first time," Oh said. "The matches have been really exciting and I'm so thankful to have Monti as my partner because she's so skilled."

Gibson said both the singles and doubles matches have so far been "a lot of fun."

"I'm lucky to have the chance to play all the matches I do and enjoy being out there representing Guam," she added.

The Billie Jean King Cup is one of the few tournaments with on-court coaching permitted. This makes Coach Smith's presence extremely vital for every match.

"Overall, we are doing very well, but I must say the expectation was to do very well," Smith said. "There is an extra bit of pressure representing Guam for the world cup. Proud of all the girls on the team for their part in how we've gone so far."

Plummer had to close the business and sell the boat in 2024 due to the decline in Japanese tourists after the COVID-19 pandemic.

"It used to be 80% to 90% of my business, but after COVID, I pretty much was out of business," he said.

For the last couple of years, his son and grandson, both licensed captains, were running the business due to Plummer's age and health problems. He was diagnosed with cancer and underwent bypass surgery.

Plummer decided not to pursue further treatment, preferring his grandkids to remember him "on the couch instead of in the hos-

pital."

After 47 years, Plummer's silent legacy is carried on with his former student-athletes and the success of his beloved sport.

Although he has stepped away from the sport and not been able to attend tournaments, he said it fills him with pride and joy whenever he reads about wrestling, track and field, or cross country.

"There are more people participating in it [now]," Plummer said. "It makes me feel really good. Not too many people know I started it [because] I don't talk about it too much. My family knows, and students from JFK back then, guys who are 65 years old and have grandchildren, will sometimes walk down the street and [yell] 'Coach Plummer!'"

Plummer has also become a well-loved member of his local community. His wife, Trudy Plummer, is originally from the Chagualaf family in Inaláhan.

Living on Guam for nearly five decades, Plummer considers himself an island local more than anything else.

"All the kids from the village call me Tata. I've really gotten into the culture with my wife, and my kids are all more CHamoru than they are haoe," he said. "Being here so long, I feel like I'm more CHamoru, even though I don't speak the language."
