NFL cheerleader," she said.

3rd year vets

With both dancers entering their NFL careers in 2023, three seasons of sideline experience has been priceless.

For Concepcion, expectations are well known now as compared to her rookie season. Adding to that is a commemorative season for the Seahawks, kicking activities into high gear.

"Lots of things are different," Concepcion said. "I had to learn a lot about how the games work. I'm able to live in the moment now because I know what to look out for during the games. The times we have to get the crowd hyped, without thinking about it too much—but the excitement is still there. Now, it's almost so normal as a regular routine."

With this year being the 50th for the Seahawks, there's a lot happening this season and they "amped up" the dancing, Concepcion said.

"Dance wise, this is the most I've done. I've been pushed a lot more technically than I ever have before. It's a big commitment, but such a fun opportunity," she said. "I would love to continue if my body would allow me to. Now is the time to keep doing it, as long as my body can. It's a rare opportunity, especially coming from Guam."


Meanwhile, Sahagon has been going through her Year 3 campaign at the opposite side of the country in Philly.

"I'm proud to be back for my third season as a Philadelphia Eagles cheerleader. Coming off a historic 2024 season, and as the reigning Super Bowl champions, this year has been incredibly exciting," she said. "The NFL season kicked off right here in Philadelphia, where

the Eagles unveiled their Super Bowl LIX Championship banner. That energy has carried into the 2025 season, and I've continued to make unforgettable memories both on and off the field."

Mutual support from afar

Though their pro cheerleading careers have paralleled in ways, the pair have

yet to cross paths.

Sahagon is from Hagat and graduated from Notre Dame in 2016, developing her dance skills with the Fusion Dance Center.

Concepcion is from Barrigada, graduated from St. John's in 2019, and is a product of SKIP.

Seattle to Philadelphia (2,800 miles) is just slightly further than Hagat and Barrigada, but thanks to

social media, the two dancers connect and support one another from afar.

"We are definitely social media friends," Concepcion said. "It's hard because they are on the opposite coast. We do comment on each other's things."

Sahagon said although she and Concepcion haven't met in person, she loves following her journey as a fellow NFL cheerleader from Guam.

"I'm grateful for the camaraderie we share and hope we can continue to be role models for dancers back home, especially since we both grew up training at studios on the island," Sahagon said. "It's incredible that for the past three NFL seasons, Guam has been represented by not one, but two cheerleaders."

With both teams punching tickets into the playoffs, could the football gods line up a chance meeting and showdown between the Eagles and Seahawks in February's Super Bowl LX in San Francisco?

"I've never met her personally, but that's definitely on my radar," Concepcion added. "Hopefully, if we meet each other in the Super Bowl."
