

definitely come back every year.”

Apatang also had an ongoing banter with a couple of Patriots fans in her row, trading shouts, team cheers, and “all days” and “let’s gos.”

When the score gap was widened in the second quarter, Apatang’s Patriots counterpart said, “That’s football.”

“It was a good fight, but you can’t compete with the Seahawks. They earned this. They’ve been respected for a long time, and the game shows for itself,” Ap-

atang said.

Seahawks fans Christian Garza, 22, from Tumon, was excited to see the Seahawks crowned champions again. He said the anticipation from the slow start to the game made for a great payoff.

“It’s been a while, so it feels great. At first, it was a really slow game. We were waiting for a touchdown to happen, and it eventually did, so it was a great feeling to see them come out on top,” Garza said.

Garza said it was an experience of “great vibes, great time, great drinks” seeing everyone cheering together.

“We were up in the front row, and with the big screen, the energy was great,” Garza said. “The standout moment was when the first touchdown was made for sure. After all that time, you could definitely hear everyone screaming and holler- ing.”

The event was sponsored by Baldyga Group and Ambrøse Inc. Other attendees told the Pacific Daily News that they enjoyed watching on the big screen instead of smaller ones at restaurants with weaker sound systems.

### The big game, 29-13

After Seattle chose to receive the ball, it quickly shaped into a defensive game, each team going pass-for-pass-for-run and not letting each other gain too much distance.

However, Seattle’s consecutive running plays allowed them to advance downfield and make use of their kicker, Jason Myers.

The first two downs already set the Seahawks up for early momentum, nearly scoring their first touchdown two minutes into the game, but the Patriots’ defense prevented further advancement.


The Seahawks took the lead, 3-0, with a field goal kick at the Patriots’ 14-yard line.

goal put the Seahawks at 19-0 with 13 minutes remaining.

The Patriots quickly responded with a touchdown of their own from Seattle’s 35, finally getting on the scoreboard, 19-7.

With only 12 minutes remaining, though, the chances of a comeback were slim.

Seattle added to its lead with 5:38 remaining via another field goal by Myers from 26 yards out.

Then, Seahawks linebacker Uchenna Nwosu intercepted a shotgun pass down the middle and bolted 45 yards to score Seattle’s second and last touchdown of the game.

The Patriots had one final touchdown two minutes before the final whistle.

New England attempted a two-point conversion instead of a field goal, but it was stopped by the Seahawks, ending the game, 29-13.
