

Money Toolbox: The final tax tune-up—what to check, what changed

"Get married before December 31...or have a baby before year-end."

That was my joking answer years ago when I was teaching an income tax class as an adjunct faculty member and a student asked how she could help family and friends reduce their taxes.

The class laughed but the lesson was real.

Life events can change tax outcomes, and there is no one-size-fits-all strategy be-

cause every taxpayer's situation is different.

Another student once asked if being a tax advisor was a good career path. I said yes, but only if you are willing to commit to continuous learning and staying current with ever-changing laws.

That is why I deeply respect colleagues who specialize in tax and dedicate themselves to mastering the details.

And now, the clock is ticking. By the time this article reaches you, business income tax deadlines may already be behind us, unless an extension was filed.

In my Money Toolbox column on March 2, I talked about tools and habits that reduce tax-season stress.

Consider this article your final tune-up—the checklist before you hit "submit."

Before you file your 2025 return

For individuals: Start with the basics. Gather all income documents—W-2s, 1099s, retirement or investment withdrawals, and any side-hustle income. Include mortgage interest statements, student loan interest forms, and other supporting records.

Review deductions and credits carefully. Education expenses, child-care, medical costs, and retirement contributions may reduce taxable income depending on your situation. Even small missed deductions can add up.

Check life changes. Marriage, divorce, new dependents, home purchases, retirement withdrawals, or a second job can significantly affect your return and filing status.

Also pay attention to federal updates under the 2025 One Big Beautiful Bill Act, OBBA. New tax advantages may apply, including de-

ductions related to qualified overtime and tip income for eligible taxpayers.

Because Guam operates under a mirror tax system, federal changes can eventually affect local filers so avoid assuming last year's rules still apply.

Remember that April 15 isn't just a deadline. It's a planning opportunity.

You may still reduce your tax payment by maximizing eligible retirement contributions before filing. Check your 2025 contribution limits and eligibility. Even small contributions can create both tax savings and long-term growth.

Income limits may apply, so consult your financial and tax advisor.

For small business, Schedule C filers:

If you run a small business or file Schedule C, don't treat tax filing as an afterthought. Preparation now saves stress—and money—later.

Before filing, confirm the essentials:

- Contractor W-9s collected and 1099 filings completed
- Payroll taxes reconciled

(if you have employees)

- Gross receipts tax and estimated income tax payments aligned with revenue
- Business expenses clearly documented — mileage, supplies, home office, and contractor payments

The 2025 OBBA provisions may also provide tax advantages tied to wage structures, including qualified overtime-related deductions. Good payroll records and organized books help you maximize benefits instead of missing them.

My simple reminder to small business owners: your records are not just for taxes. They are the foundation of better decisions and stronger growth.

Need more time? File an extension: For individuals, Form 4868. For businesses, Form 7004. An extension gives more time to file.

Estimated taxes should still be paid by the original deadline to avoid penalties and interest.

Don't DIY complex taxes

"DIY" means do it yourself. While that may work for simple returns, it can be risky when taxes become more complex.

If your return includes business income, multiple income sources, rental activity, or major deductions, working with a qualified tax professional can help prevent costly mistakes.

Wellness Wednesday: Kindness for the kidneys

World Kidney Day will be celebrated tomorrow, March 12. This year's theme is "Kidney Health for All - Caring for People, Protecting the Planet."

Your kidneys are two fist-sized organs that filter waste and excess fluid from your blood, and many people never think about them until something goes wrong.

At which point the damage can be devastating for individuals, families, and communities.

The kidneys regulate blood pressure, balance electrolytes like sodium and potassium. They support red blood cell production and maintain bone health through vitamin D activation.

Chronic kidney disease is the gradual loss of kidney function over time.

Early stages produce no symptoms, which means it is possible to lose a significant amount of kidney function before you feel a thing.

8 golden rules of healthy kidneys

Kidney disease is largely preventable. These eight strategies can help you take control of your kidney health.

Control blood pressure. High blood pressure damages the tiny blood vessels in your kidneys over time. A target generally below 120/80 mmHg is ideal. The DASH diet, which emphasizes fruits, vegetables, whole grains, and low sodium foods, has been shown to reduce blood pressure.

If your doctor prescribes medication, take it consistently. Regular monitoring keeps you informed and in control.

Manage blood sug-

ar. If you have diabetes, tight glucose control reduces the risk of diabetic kidney damage. Routine A1C monitoring helps you and your health care team track progress.

People with Type 2 diabetes who achieve an A1C below 7% reduce their risk of kidney disease by roughly 30%.

Eat a kidney-friendly diet. Reduce sodium intake to ideally less than 2,300 milligrams per day. Avoid adding salt to your food, and prepare food at home rather than eating at restaurants, so you have more control over the sodium.

Focus on getting in your daily servings of fruits, vegetables, and whole grains. Keep protein intake moderate and avoid excessive high-protein diets unless medically supervised.

Limit ultra-processed foods, added sugars, and sugar sweetened beverages.

Maintain a healthy weight. Obesity increases your risk of both diabetes and high blood pressure, the two leading causes of chronic kidney disease.

Regular physical activity for at least 150 minutes per week of moderate exercise, such as brisk walking, helps.

Even small amounts of weight loss can ease the burden on your kidneys.

Stay hydrated. Water is your kidneys' best friend. Adequate water intake supports kidney filtration and helps flush waste from your body.

Avoid excessive sugar sweetened drinks. Plain water is the simplest, most effective choice.

One trick for making sure you drink enough water is taking your weight in pounds and dividing that number in half. Use that number to determine how many ounces of water a person should have in a day. For example, if a person weighs 150 lbs., they should be drinking at least 75 oz. of water daily.

Limit alcohol intake. Excess alcohol raises blood pressure and adds strain to your kidneys.

Avoid overuse of certain pain relievers. Frequent overuse of some common over-the-counter pain medications, like non-steroidal

anti-inflammatory or a pain-killer like ibuprofen, can harm your kidneys.

Use pain relievers responsibly and talk to your doctor if you rely on them regularly.

Don't smoke. Smoking reduces blood flow to your kidneys, which can affect organ function. It increases the risk of kidney cancer by about 50% and speeds up chronic kidney disease progression.

Quitting is one of the best things you can do for your kidneys and your overall health.

Get your kidneys checked if you have one or more risk factors. If you have diabetes, high blood pressure, a family history of kidney disease, obesity or are over 60, talk to your doctor about screening.

Two simple tests can reveal a lot. A blood test called eGFR measures how well your kidneys filter. For this test, a result of more than 60 is ideal.

A urine test checks for albumin, a protein that signals kidney damage.

An ideal uACR test result would be less than 30.

Early detection matters because chronic kidney disease progression can be slowed with early intervention. Lifestyle changes are most effective when you catch problems early.

Know the warning signs

See your doctor if you experience persistent swelling, unexplained fatigue, changes in urination, or high blood pressure that is hard to control. These can be signs that your kidneys need attention. Don't ignore them.

Protect your kidneys by knowing three numbers: your blood pressure, your A1C or fasting glucose, and your eGFR. Ask your doctor for all three at your next visit.

Schedule a check-up. Do your labs.

You and your kidneys will be happy you did.
