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The momentum generated in Seoul is already producing measurable results. Tournament organizers report increased registrations and inquiries from Korean athletes interested in competing at upcoming Guam-based events, including the Guam Marianas Dumau Championship and the Guam Marianas Open International Championship.

This growing pipeline of international participants represents a meaningful opportunity for Guam's visitor industry. Each athlete arriving with coaches, family members, and supporters, creating a multiplier effect that benefits hotels, restaurants, transportation providers, retail establishments, and other local businesses, organizers said.

"The growth we witnessed in Korea exceeded our expectations and further validates the international appeal of the Guam Marianas Pro Series," said Steve Shimizu, president of the Marianas Open, in a statement.

"To nearly double participation from our previous event is a remarkable achievement and a testament to the credibility, professionalism, and competitive opportunities our organization has established throughout the region. More importantly, it demonstrates how sports can serve as a bridge connecting Guam with communities throughout Asia and beyond," he added.

Shimizu said that the continued expansion of the series reflects a long-term vision of positioning Guam as a premier destination for international martial arts competition.

"We are not simply organizing tournaments. We are building an international platform that promotes Guam, creates meaningful economic impact, strength-

ens regional partnerships, and provides opportunities for athletes of all ages to experience our island and our culture," he said.

A key component of that success has been the ongoing support of the Guam Visitors Bureau, whose partnership has helped expand the reach of the Guam Marianas Open throughout Asia and the Pacific.

As participation numbers continue to rise and international interest grows, the Guam Marianas Pro Series remains committed to expanding opportunities for athletes throughout the Asia-Pacific region while bringing increasing numbers of visitors to Guam through competition, education, and cultural exchange.
