"I pray to my grandma Trini before my fights. She is always there for me. It also makes me feel closer to my ancestors. I have so much support from others who are from the island," she said.

Tāsi is named after her grandmother Trinidad Cruz Reyes from Hāgat. Tāsi's full name is Tāsi-Trinidad Marley Boots.

Women's nationals

Just last week, Tāsi went 8-3 in the USA Wrestling Women's National Duals as part of Team Oregon. It is the premier girls-only team wrestling tournament in the country, featuring state all-star teams

competing in freestyle and Greco-Roman styles. The event is a massive recruiting showcase for college coaches, as women's collegiate wrestling continues to grow rapidly.

Team Oregon went on to win the tournament as Tāsi's wins helped the cause. All her wins came via pins in less than a minute.

The busy part of her competition season is over. The one competition she has left is the Beach Wrestling State Championships in August on the Oregon Coast. It will be her first time competing at such an event, but mostly she wants to spend the summer putting more on muscle and working her technique.

		1. Dean Scott Steinberger The Board discussed concerns regarding the clarity of the licensure application process, particularly as it relates to applications by endorsement. Members noted that the current application checklist may be confusing for applicants and emphasized the need for a consistent understanding among Board members regarding endorsement requirements and the applicable statutory provisions. Discussion centered on the interpretation of the checklist, with members observing that items one through eleven appear to be required for both licensure by examination and licensure by endorsement, while additional items are specifically required for endorsement applicants. The Board reviewed a pending application submitted by Dr. Steinberger and noted that the applicant may have interpreted the checklist as requiring only the endorsement-specific documents. Members agreed that a formal response should be provided to clarify the application requirements and the Board’s interpretation of the checklist. The Board further discussed the need to revise the application materials to improve clarity and reduce confusion for future applicants.
