GPA HOSTS CANNED FOOD DRIVE FOR CATHOLIC SOCIAL SERVICE AND THE SALVATION ARMY

Community invited to donate canned goods at any GPA customer service center

(Fadian, Guam) – Guam Power Authority announced today that it is hosting a canned food drive to benefit two of Guam's charities – Catholic Social Service and the Salvation Army Guam – as part of its Public Power Week celebration that will begin on October 2, 2022. - Canned fruits fruit cocktail, peaches, pears, etc.
- Canned vegetables corn and green beans, but no lentils or beans, please
- Rice uncooked rice in 5 lb. or 10 lb. bag quantities
