Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency Announces the Opening of its FY 2025 Grant Cycle

[Hagåtña, Guam, April 22, 2024] – The Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency, is pleased to announce the opening of its FY 2025 Grant Cycle. The agency will be accepting applications for grants and fellowships for the upcoming year in a wide range of disciplines, including Arts-in-Education, Performing Arts, Visual Arts, Folk Arts, Humanities, Literature, Underserved, and Media Arts. The project period for the FY 2025 grant cycle is from October 1, 2024, to September 30, 2025.

To be eligible to apply, interested applicants are required to attend one of the grant workshops scheduled to be held on Saturday, April 27, 2024, and May 11, 2024, starting at 9:00 am. Additionally, a preliminary application must be submitted to the CAHA by 4:00 pm on Friday, June 28, 2024. It is essential for applicants to fulfill both prerequisites before they can submit a final application to CAHA.

The free grant workshops will take place at CAHA, DNA Building, Suite 202, 238 Archbishop Flores Street in Hagåtña. The workshops will commence promptly at 9:00 am. and provide crucial information for potential applicants. Applications can be obtained at CAHA or downloaded from the agency's website at www.guamcaha.org beginning April 30, 2024 .

This is an excellent opportunity for artists and individuals in the cultural and artistic communities to secure funding for their projects and initiatives.

The final deadline for submissions of all applications and supporting materials is 4:00 pm. on Wednesday, July 31, 2024. To apply, organizations must send their applications via email to grants@caha.guam.gov or submit them directly to CAHA located in the DNA Building, Suite 202.
