Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Hagåtña, Guam – The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), through the Guam Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program, joins survivors, families, advocates, and partners in observing **Breast Cancer Awareness Month this October.**

This month is more than awareness. It is a time to honor the courage of survivors, remember those we have lost, and unite as one island community to protect future generations. According to the **Pacific Regional Central Cancer Registry 2007 to 2022 report**, it was the most common adult invasive cancer across the U.S. Pacific and remains the **second most diagnosed cancer on Guam**. Behind these numbers are mothers, daughters, sisters, and friends whose lives and families have been forever changed. With early detection and treatment, lives can be saved. Screenings and mammograms remain one of the most powerful gifts of health and hope.

"On Guam, breast cancer is not a distant issue. It lives in our homes, in our families, and in the stories of our loved ones," said Director Theresa C. Arriola. "This month, we stand together in pink to honor the survivors among us, to remember those we have lost, and to remind every woman that early detection can save her life. When our island unites with courage and compassion, we give hope to every family facing this fight."
