The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) is inviting the public to review and comment on the Draft Action Plan for the Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) program, known as "Fix in Six." The comment period will run from **Wednesday, May 1, 2025**, and conclude on **Monday, June 2, 2025, at 11:59pm**. As part of this process, GHURA will hold three public hearings to gather community input. These hearings will be held in the northern, central, and southern regions to ensure accessibility to residents across the island.

- Tuesday, May 20, 2025, 6:00pm at the Hagat Mayor's Office Community Center
- Thursday, May 22, 2025, 6:00pm at the Yigo Gymnasium

In December 2024, GHURA was designated to manage \$500.8 million in CDBG-DR funds to help low- to moderate-income (LMI) households recover from Typhoon Mawar. The "Fix in Six" program is funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and supports long-term recovery in communities affected by natural disasters. Over the next six years, it will support LMI communities, expand access to affordable housing, improve public infrastructure, strengthen mitigation efforts, and create economic opportunities to bolster the island's economy.
