## Fix in Six Expands October Outreach Opportunities for CDBG-DR Education

The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) continues its public outreach efforts for the Guam Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Fix in Six program. The agency would like to thank all participants, including members of the public and representatives from the island's mayors' offices, for their continued interest and engagement in helping restore and strengthen our community.

October public outreach events:

These outreach efforts will provide information to help potential applicants understand program eligibility, project feasibility, and the documents needed to prepare for the application process. Public outreach will continue through December, with sessions offered during weekdays, evenings, and weekends, to allow wide community participation.

*“These outreaches allow us to see not only how many of our people are still recovering from Typhoon Mawar, but also which agencies and organizations are ready to play a key role in helping Guam prepare for future disasters,”* said GHURA Deputy Director and Fix in Six Grant Manager Fernando Esteves. *“We thank everyone who has attended or shown interest in the Fix in Six program. Together, we will build effective long-term solutions for a stronger, more resilient Guam.”*

GHURA encourages potential applicants to complete a series of short surveys available on the Fix in Six website. Which will help the agency assess community needs in preparation for the upcoming application process. *CDBG-DR funds are provided by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to support long-term recovery efforts in communities affected by natural disasters. In January 2025, GHURA was designated to manage \$500.8 million dollars in CDBG-DR funds to help low- to moderate-income (LMI) households recover from Typhoon Mawar. Over the next six years, Fix in Six will help LMI communities by supporting affordable housing, improving public infrastructure, creating economic opportunities, and strengthening mitigation efforts.*
