#### General Public Outreach Event on Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Public Infrastructure & Facilities Program

This ad is paid for by the Guam Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery funds (DR-4715-GU) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) CDBG-DR will be hosting a public outreach event focused on the Public Facilities & Infrastructure (PFI) Program Allocation of \$43,375,000 and invites stakeholders to attend. This specific outreach event is designed to engage in stakeholder participation and provide essential information about the CDBG-DR Public Facilities and Infrastructure program requirements, eligibility criteria, and submission procedures to ensure that potential applicants are well-informed before engaging in the Technical Assistance (TA) process. **Eligible applicants** are government agencies and established non-profit organizations holding a 501(c)3 status. **Outreach Requirement** - Eligible Applicants or entities intending to apply for GHURA CDBG-DR Public Facilities and Infrastructure program funding **must attend a scheduled outreach event** prior to requesting Technical Assistance (TA). Outreach sessions will provide essential information about program requirements, eligibility criteria, and submission procedures to ensure that potential applicants are well-informed before engaging in the TA process. Attendance at the outreach event will be documented as part of the applicant's program file. Projects will be evaluated and selected based on eligibility and feasibility, other criteria specifically to meet the CDBG-DR requirement to benefit low- and moderate-income (LMI) individuals and families, particularly after a disaster.

**Mitigation Measures** - In addition but not limited to eligibility, feasibility and meeting the LMI objective, mitigation measures will be incorporated into project design in accordance with local building codes and applicable federal requirements. These measures aim to minimize potential adverse impacts and enhance the resilience of funded projects against future natural hazards.

**Environmental Review** - All CDBG-DR funds and eligible activities must be in accordance with 24 CFR Part 58.4. The GHURA CDBG-DR is responsible for ensuring that all program activities comply with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and other applicable environmental laws and authorities prior to the commitment of federal funds.
