DPHSS Encourages Participation in the 2026 Guam Community Health Survey

Hagåtña, Guam – The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) announces the 2026 Guam Community Health Survey. Residents of Guam who are 18 years of age or older are encouraged to participate.

The 2026 Guam Community Health Survey is designed to collect input from the island community regarding health issues, concerns, and priorities affecting Guam. The responses will be used to inform the development of the Community Health Assessment, a comprehensive picture of Guam's current health status, factors contributing to higher health risks or poorer health outcomes, and community resources available to improve health.
