Get Immunized Guam! Protect Yourself From Pertussis!

Hagåtña, Guam – In response to the recently confirmed 7th pertussis case, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) will conduct a **FREE Pertussis immunization clinic** for children and adults on **March 30, 2026**. The one-day clinic will provide critical pertussis vaccinations for eligible individuals.

Pertussis Immunization Outreach Clinic

- Date: March 30, 2026
- Time: 10:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. (or while supplies last)
- Location: George Washington High School (GWHS) Cafeteria, Mangilao
- Eligibility:
 - Children 2 months - 18 years old without health insurance or those covered by Medicaid or MIP
 - Adults 19 years and older without health insurance
- Available Vaccines:
 - DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis) vaccination for infants and young children.
 - Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccination for adolescents and adults

Requirements:

- Children under 18 years of age:
 - Child's current shot record (yellow shot card)
 - Must be accompanied by a parent. If accompanied by another adult, legal documentation or written authorization from the parent is required.
 - Child's birth certificate
 - Parent, guardian, or authorized adult's valid photo ID
- Adults must bring a photo ID and a current shot record (yellow shot card), if available

 1. Must be accompanied by a parent. If other than parent, adult must have legal documents or written authorization from parent.
 2. Child's Birth Certificate
 3. Parent, guardian or authorized adult's photo ID.
 4. Current shot record (Yellow Shot Card)
